



Game Recap #11 (Rancho Buena Vista)

The Quick Hit:

Torrey Pines dominated the defensive end tonight and beat Rancho Buena Vista 76-31 less than 24 hours after yesterday's battle with Poway. The Falcons didn't allow a field goal for the first nine minutes of the game and had only allowed 12 points at the halftime break. Brandon Angel had 20 points in the first half to lead the offense.

The Players:

Brandon Angel was once again the leading scorer for the Falcons with 20 points. He also added nine rebounds in only three quarters of play. Otto Landrum recorded no stats in the first quarter but added 16 points and six rebounds in the next three quarters. He was a perfect 8/8 from the field. Chris Howell had his best game of the year, both in impact and statistics. He had a double-double with 10 points & 10 rebounds, and was close to a triple-double (seven assists), but like Angel only played in the first three quarters. Matias Clotfelter was impactful again with four points, four rebounds and three steals. Cameron Klein had eight points through three quarters and was 3/3 from the field.

The Game:

The Falcons began the game on a 10-0 run before Rancho Buena Vista called a timeout four minutes in. Chris Howell had two points, rebounds, steals and assists in that span. RBV finally found the scoreboard with 2:43 left in the first on a single free throw. That was their only point of the quarter – 19-1 Falcons after one. The first bucket for the Longhorns was a Jack Bailey three with 6:57 left in the second quarter. Otto Landrum had the first six points for the Falcons before Angel rattled off three straight buckets of his own. Angel added nine points in the quarter to give him 20 for the half and a 42-12 Falcons lead. Chris Howell had eight points in the third quarter and Nick Herrmann scored his five points in the contest during the period. The lead was extended to 39 points, 63-24, at the end of three. With a big lead, every player saw action. Otto Landrum led all scorers in the quarter with six points and Dechaun Key added five en route to a 76-31 final.

The Falcons are off tomorrow before hosting the biggest game of the year thus far on Monday night: #2 Cathedral Catholic at 8:00 pm. This is the feature game of three for the Holiday Classic Tip-Off Night on December 23rd.
