

# Game Recap #2 (El Centro Southwest)

November 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2019 Torrey Pines High School

### The Quick Hit:

The Falcons moved to 2-0 on the season with a dominating 87-20 win over El Centro Southwest. The game was never close from the start, as the Falcons opened up a 10-0 lead 80 seconds into the game, a 20-0 lead halfway through the first quarter and 31-2 lead after the end of the first quarter. From there, every Falcon got a chance to contribute throughout the final three quarters.

## The Players:

Senior Luke Pisacane put up a career and game high of 16 points. Pisacane was 6/9 from the field and 4/6 from behind the arc. Senior Sean Doyle had 2 points and a game high 6 rebounds. Nearly every Falcon scored with four in double digits: Pisacane (16), Brandon Angel (13), Diego Campisano (12) and Nick Herrmann (11). All except Pisacane started the game and saw little-to-no action in the second half. Finally, junior Chris Howell put up another exceptional stat line: 7 points, 3 rebounds, 3 assists, 4 steals and 4 blocks on a perfect 3/3 from the field.

#### The Game:

Much like Wednesday against Westview, the Falcons came out scoring. El Centro Southwest was forced into three timeouts within the first six minutes of the game. Two of those were called after two separate monster Brandon Angel dunks. The Falcons nearly shut the Eagles out in the first quarter, but they hit a bucket as the buzzer sounded to make the score 31-2 after one quarter. The Torrey Pines offense didn't slow down in the second quarter and led 56-12 at halftime. Many of the starters for the Falcons didn't play in the second half, but the rest of the team kept the momentum to make the score after three period 80-19. The final was 87-20.

## They Said It:

"The offense moved the ball real well tonight" said leading scorer Luke Pisacane, "and I got to open spots on the floor where I knew I could knock down shots." Pisacane hit four 3-pointers on the night.
