



Game Recap #22 (Canyon Crest)

The Quick Hit:

Once again finding themselves down after one quarter and the first half, the Falcons rallied to win the second half 33-19 and the ball game 64-56 over Canyon Crest. Brandon Angel led with 27 points, including 11 in the second quarter to keep the Falcons close.

The Players:

Brandon Angel had the aforementioned 27 points along with eight rebounds and three assists. Cameron Klein was the second leading scorer with nine points and three rebounds. Nick Herrmann had eight points, four rebounds, four assists and three steals. Nate Witte had eight points and four assists, including 4/5 from two. All Falcons combined to shoot 27/44 from two and only had seven turnovers on the night.

Brandon Angel now has 961 career points and tonight passed Jake Gilliam to move to 9th on the career leading scorers since 2004.

The Game:

Cameron Klein led the game off with four quick points. Five Falcons scored in the quarter with a balanced effort. However, the Ravens were hot from the field and led 20-18 after a quarter. In the second period, the Ravens didn't cool off. Brandon Angel did his best to keep the Falcons in range, scoring 11 of the team's 13 points in the quarter, but it wasn't enough to move into the lead. Canyon Crest won the quarter 17-13 and led 37-31 at the break. The beginning of the second half saw some life from the Falcons. The first 2:47 of the third quarter saw an 8-2 Falcons run force a Ravens timeout. Brandon Angel had two baskets that bookended Cameron Klein and Chris Howell layups during the opening stretch. With 56 seconds left in the third, a Cameron Klein three gave the Falcons their first lead since 2-0 to begin the game. This was only the second three-pointer for the Falcons in the game and helped propel them to a 51-48 lead at the end of the third. The fourth saw both defenses clamp down. The game was tied or within a basket throughout the first seven minutes before a Nate Witte reverse layup with 53 seconds to go gave the Falcons a two-point lead. Canyon Crest came down and missed a wide-open layup with 35 seconds left, which led to a Chris Howell rebound kicked up to Nate Witte then Matias Clotfelter for a game-sealing layup before some free throws and a Brandon Angel dunk widened the margin. The final: 64-56.

Next Up:

On Friday night, the Falcons will host the Lancers of Carlsbad as they look to move to 6-0 in the Avocado West. In the January 14th matchup at Carlsbad, Torrey Pines beat the Lancers 70-48. Tip off will be at 7:00 pm.
