



Game Recap #23 (Carlsbad)

The Quick Hit:

The Falcons won three of the four quarters tonight on their way to a 59-48 win at home against Carlsbad. Nick Herrmann led the Falcons with 14 points and was one of three players to reach double-digit points. Chris Howell had a great performance running the point – more on that below.

The Players:

Nick Herrmann was the aforementioned leader in points for the Falcons with 14. Cameron Klein had 11 points with three rebounds and two assists. Brandon Angel was the third Falcon in double-digits with 10 points, and he also added eight rebounds, three assists and three steals. Chris Howell had another phenomenal stat line: Eight points, 10 rebounds and nine assists. Nate Witte came off the bench to contribute seven points including a perfect 2/2 from two.

The Game:

Diego Campisano started the game hot for the Falcons with seven points in the first five minutes. Both teams defended well, leading to a low-scoring 14-11 quarter in favor of the Falcons. At the start of the second, Carlsbad went on a 7-0 run to flip the lead to 18-14 in their favor. Following a Torrey Pines timeout, the Falcons went on a 10-0 run of their own and regained the lead at 24-18. A big moment during that stretch to rally the home crowd was a Nick Herrmann steal and assist to Brandon Angel for a big one-hand slam with 2:45 to go in the half. The lead was 26-24 Falcons at the break. Another 7-2 run for the Falcons to start the opening 2:30 of the third quarter helped stretch the Falcons lead to the largest of the game at that point. The third period saw Nick Herrmann score six of his 14 points tonight to help make the lead 44-38 Torrey Pines after 24 minutes. The Lancers started the fourth with an alley-oop to Caleb Nelson to cut the lead to four, but from there, the Falcons kept them at bay. Nate Witte had five points, including a corner three to push the lead to double digits and put the game out of reach. Chris Howell had four assists in the quarter. The final was 59-48 Falcons.

Next Up:

The Falcon will take on Mission Hills on the road next Tuesday to kick off their February slate. The game is at 7:00 pm and is the seventh in the Avocado West for both ball clubs.
