



Game Recap #27 (San Marcos)

The Quick Hit:

The Falcons won three of the four quarters tonight on their way to a 74-48 win. The lead was 18 at half and, though San Marcos cut it to 14 in the third quarter, the game was out of reach pretty much the entire second half. The Falcons received scoring from nine different players on the evening.

The Players:

Brandon Angel once again led the Falcons with 28 points, tying his season-high, and nine rebounds. Angel was 6/10 from two, 3/4 from deep, and 7/7 from the foul line for an excellent night shooting. Nick Herrmann and Chris Howell were the other two Falcons to reach double digit scoring – Herrmann with 11 and Howell with 10. Notably, Herrmann was 4/6 from two and Howell added a team-high four assists. Matias Clotfelter once again played big minutes off the bench. He contributed five points, five rebounds and three assists along with solid defense.

The Game:

Devon Arlington started the game off with a three for the Knights, but the Falcons dominated the rest of the first quarter. Brandon Angel had six points to lead the team in the quarter. It was 19-9 Torrey Pines after one. The Falcons progressively built their lead larger and larger in the second period. Angel erupted for 13 points in the quarter, and at halftime the Falcons held their largest lead of the game to that point, 42-24. A big focus for the team in the first half was the offensive glass. The Falcons had seven offensive rebounds in the first 16 minutes. In the second half, the Falcons began with a quick four points from Diego Campisano. However, Chris Howell came out for a few minutes after turning his ankle and the Knights made their biggest run of the game. What was a 22 point lead became a 14 point lead in a matter of three minutes, and the Falcons called timeout with two minutes left in the third and the score 48-34. The margin was 14 at the end of the quarter as well, 54-40. In the fourth, Brandon Angel and Nick Herrmann each had six points early on to put the game beyond a doubt. The score became 70-43 about halfway through the period before the benches were emptied. Dechaun Key added four points for the Falcons in the closing minutes as the final tally was a 74-48 victory for the Falcons.

The regular season finale is Thursday night at 7:00 pm in the Olive Garden against rival La Costa Canyon. This will also be senior night as we celebrate Brandon Angel, Sean Doyle and Dechaun Key.
