

# Game Recap #5 (Granite Hills)

December 4th, 2019 Granite Hills High School

#### The Quick Hit:

The Falcons string together back-to-back wins and get to 4-1 on the season with a 70-49 win on the road at Granite Hills. Brandon Angel had a game high 20 points and hauled in a third consecutive double-double while Diego Campisano scored a season high 16 points. As a team, the Falcons made 27 field goals, 19 of which came off assists (70% of FG), and limited their turnovers to only eight for the game.

### The Players:

As he now has in four of the Falcons' five games this season, Brandon Angel led the way in scoring with 20 points. Angel also had 10 rebounds to collect his third straight double-double. Diego Campisano had an aforementioned season high of 16 points on 8/10 shooting. Cameron Klein had eight points, including two three-pointers, along with three rebounds and four assists. Nick Herrmann has now scored double digits in all five games for the Falcons this season after contributing 11 points tonight.

#### The Game:

After a slow beginning to the game saw the Eagles take a 7-4 lead, the Falcons answered back with a 8-0 run in the middle of the first quarter, punctuated by back-to-back threes from Cameron Klein and Brandon Angel. Both teams picked it up in the latter half of the period and had little trouble finding the net in the last few minutes, with the Falcons leading 21-15 after one. Brandon Angel had eight points in the first quarter and followed that up with 10 points in the second quarter. He was the primary reason the Falcons saw themselves widen the margin by nine points to lead 41-26 at half. Torrey Pines appeared to have blown the game open midway through the third quarter, but a few costly turnovers in the last two minutes led to a late Granite Hills 6-0 run. After three, the scoreboard read Falcons 56, Eagles 39. Angel only played one minute to start the fourth quarter, and the Falcons cleared the rest of their starters midway through the period en route to a 70-49 win.
