# **ontarget Club Competition**

## **A CLUB VERSUS CLUB CHALLENGE**

The 2019 **ontarget** Club Competition is now open and accepting entries.

All **ontarget** clubs<sup>1</sup> are welcome to enter this competition which aims to boost the idea that competition can be fun!

Comprising of a series of knockout rounds and a Finals event, the **ontarget** club competition will allow you to meet new people from clubs you may not have come across and opens up the opportunity for team bonding, fun and the chance to experience archery in other parts of the country. The winning club will receive a trophy and prize money. Runners up will also receive a trophy and prize money.

### **Format**

The **ontarget** Club Competition is a knockout team competition where clubs host or travel to a match. Clubs are initially drawn with others from their Counties or Regions to minimise travel.

Matches take 2 hours and will consist of 3 rounds of 2 dozen arrows at 50m on an 80cm face, with archers shooting ends of 6 arrows. Each round sees the team shoot as Team, a Pair and finally as an Individual against the other team's archers.

### **Teams for 2019**

Each team consists of four (4) archers of whom 2 must be recurve archers, 2 must be compound archers,.

The team of archers must be mixed gender and archers should be 14 years old or older.

A Longbow/Barebow division will be piloted in 2019.

The Finals event will take place on Sunday 1 September 2019.

### **Social**

An important, and welcomed, factor of the competition is the social aspect. Home teams are encouraged to provide refreshments, and a chance to socialise with other archers and clubs.

In the past clubs have welcomed more than the opposition team, and allowed other archers to come, shoot and socialise. This is to be encouraged, however should not interfere with the timing of the match. A key part is to keep the match to approximately 2 hours.

## Entry

**ontarget** clubs are now invited to take part.

Entry is £30 per team. **There is an early bird offer of £15 per team for entries submitted before 11 March 2019.** Entries are only accepted on the Sport:80 website - <https://agb.sport80.com> - and this can only be done by the club secretary or those with club access.

Clubs are encouraged to read the **ontarget** Competition Rules 2019 document before entering a team.

If you cancel your place before the event entry closing date, you will receive a refund minus 20% of the event entry fee. If you cancel your place after the event entry closing date, you will not receive a refund. All refunds are administered 5 working days after the completion of the event.

## Stages

Matches are shot in Stages, and each match should take place within a time band for each stage. Winning teams will advance to the next stage. Losing teams from Stage 1 will be entered in to the repechage.

Entry Information	<p>By entering this Archery GB competition you agree that the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors. Refunds and cancellations	If you wish to cancel your space and get a refund please contact the relevant competition e-mail address found on the prospectus. No refunds will be available 28 days prior to the competition date.
Age groups	Archers should be aged 14 and over.

Urgent event notifications will be published at <a href="http://www.archerygb.org">www.archerygb.org</a> and all social media platforms where necessary, and emailed directly to the competition team managers
Rounds	For any further questions regarding the competition round, please contact the competition contact.
Dress code	Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations.
Practice	Practice will take place 30 minutes before each match.
Assistance	Please ensure the organisers are aware of any special requirements you may have. Archers who are unable to get to the target could you please try to arrange for assistance to aid in scoring & arrow collection. If this is not possible please contact the organiser directly who will assist, this must be least 7 days prior to entry.
Event formats	Event formats can be changed on the day due to unforeseen circumstances by the competition manager, competition organiser and judge in collaboration with competitors.
Lost Arrows	<p>Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party (please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow).</p> <p>It is the archer's responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the field.</p>
Photography	<p>In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Policy, those who wish to take photographs or video at this event are to register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival. Unauthorised photography is not permitted.</p> <p>Photos and video taken at this event may be used by Archery GB across its communication channels to promote the sport. If you are concerned about any photography and videos taking place at this event, or do not wish to be photographed please contact the tournament organiser directly.</p>
Smoking	<p>Please observe the policy of each club.</p> <p>Finals Event: We are bound by Lilleshall's smoking policy which says no smoking on the sports pitches. Therefore, the smoking area is on the access road. Please note that this rule applies to those using electronic cigarettes or vaping.</p>

Line tents	No tents to be erected until the morning of the event.
Pets	Animals, except for assistance animals, are not permitted at Lilleshall National Sports and Conferencing Centre.
Pavilion café	At the Finals event food may be available from the Lilleshall shop in the Cricket Pavilion and the Main Bar. Please note there will be a selection of hot and cold food available from 8am.
Car Parking	Parking is limited near the shooting field, please follow the steward's instructions.
