RUSWIN FRANCISCO is a film and theater actor, producer, and jazz vocalist with more than 30 years of performance experience spanning stage, screen, and live broadcast. He appeared as Manny and served as producer in *The Girl Who Left Home*, which won Best Picture at the DC Asian Pacific American Film Festival. His theater credits include principal roles such as Simba in *The Lion King*, Lun Tha in *The King and I*, the Pharoah in *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*, and Bernardo in *West Side Story*.

In addition to his acting work, Francisco is an experienced producer and director, and an accredited investor in Broadway productions. A fluent Tagalog speaker and accomplished jazz vocalist, he brings depth, vocal strength, and cultural authenticity to character-driven roles across film, television, and theater.
