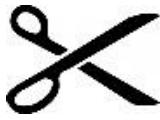
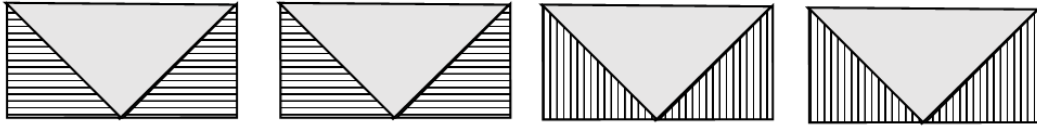

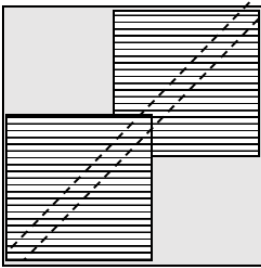


Companion for Studio180 Design Love Links (Pattern #MOD-010)

PART 1 – Make 4 Flying Geese, two vertical and two horizontal small triangle sets



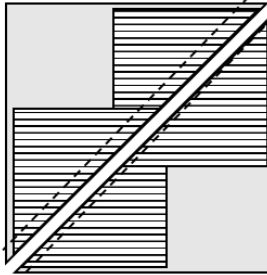
Step 1



Position 2 small directional fabric squares with the pattern positioned **horizontally** on 1 background square.

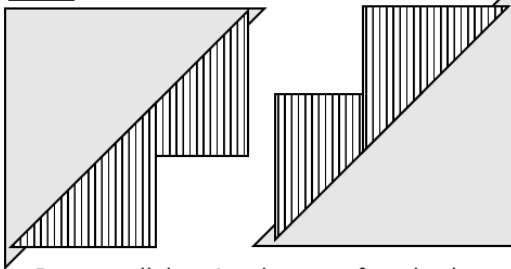
Mark and stitch on parallel $\frac{1}{4}$ " lines.

Step 2



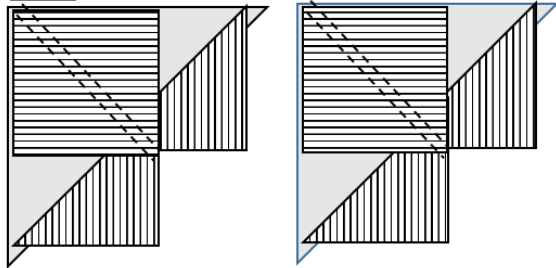
Cut between the parallel stitching lines.

Step 3



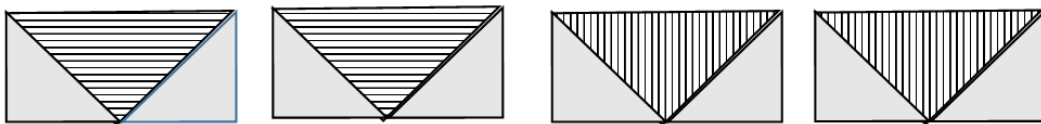
Press small the triangles away from background.

Step 4

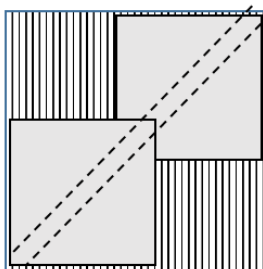


Position 1 small directional fabric square with the pattern running **horizontally** on each previously pieced Step 3 units. Mark and stitch on parallel $\frac{1}{4}$ " line. Follow your wing clipper directions to complete.

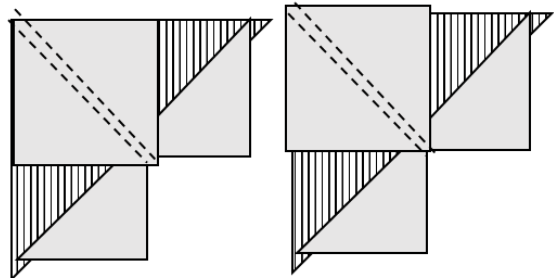
PART 2 – Make 4 Flying Geese, two vertical and two horizontal large triangle sets



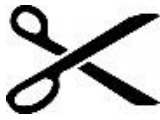
Step 1



Position the large square with the directional pattern positioned vertically and place 2 small background fabric squares on the large square. Follow the first series of steps for making flying geese: Mark, stitch, press and cut!

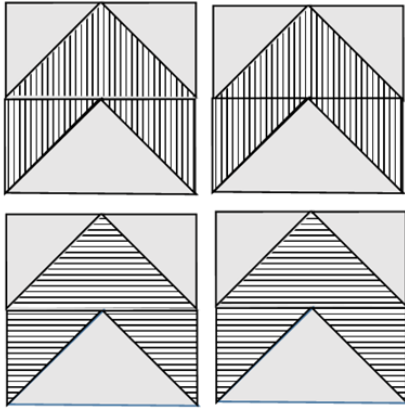


Step 2 Position a small directional background square on each previous pieced Step 3 units. Mark and stitch on parallel $\frac{1}{4}$ " lines. (Make two)

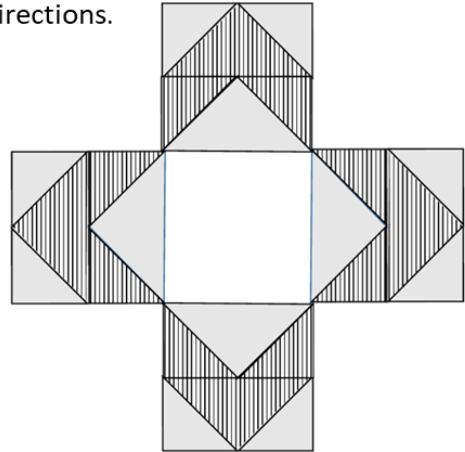


Part 3—Make chevron blocks and assemble in the links in the quilt

Pair the Chevrons from Part 1 and Part 2 together, horizontal and vertical units together. Press per pattern directions.

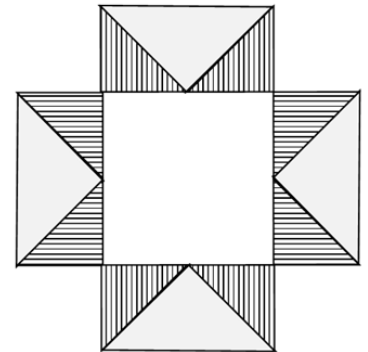
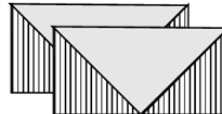
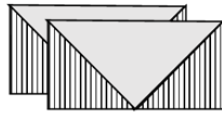


Arrange the chevrons in you quilt to create the links with the chevrons in the same directions.

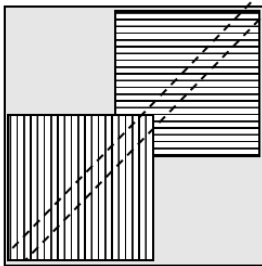


BONUS – Directional Flying Geese – Small triangles same direction

Makes four vertical small triangle sets



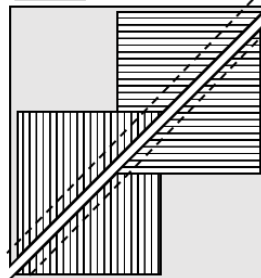
Step 1



Position 2 stripe fabric squares with the pattern positioned vertically on 1 background square.

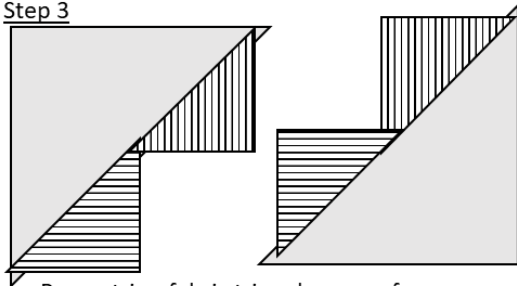
Mark and stitch on parallel 1/4" lines.

Step 2



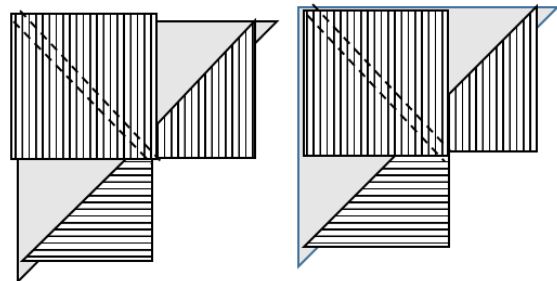
Cut between parallel stitching lines.

Step 3



Press stripe fabric triangles away from background.

Step 4



Position 1 small stripe fabric square with the pattern running vertically on each Step 3 unit. Mark and stitch on parallel 1/4" lines. Follow your wing clipper directions to complete.
