Scholarship Application and Essay Instructions

(Only current Central High School Seniors can apply)

Please review the following for eligibility requirements, the application process, and take note of the deadline of **April 30, 2026, at 5:00 pm.**

You will need to complete the application in full, submit proof of your GPA and your school transcripts. Your school transcripts must be complete and include grades 9 through 12.

You will also need to obtain two letters of recommendation. One letter must be from a teacher and the other letter should come from a community member. You may include optional letters.

You must include a written essay with a minimum of 250 words.

Please complete each requested field. If you do not have the information, please indicate N/A.

Educational Background:

Please complete each requested field. Please note you will need to attach proof of your GPA and your most recent school transcripts. When completing the intended major question, please choose the major closest to your own/intention.

Relevant Activities/Awards:

- Employment History – Enter up to three recent jobs. If you do not have employment experience, leave blank.
- Honors and Awards – Enter up to five honors or awards you have received. If you do not have any, indicate N/A.
- Extracurricular Activities and volunteering experiences - Enter up to three activities in which you have participated. If you do not have any, indicate N/A.

Financial Information:

Please include the requested financial information from either the FAFSA eligibility or the 2025 1040 income tax form.

Essay:

The essay is the most important part of the application. The essay must be a minimum of 250 words. Your essay should be typed and single spaced, except when spaces separate paragraphs on a separate page (not provided).

Please discuss at least one of the following points in your essay.

1. Some students have a background, identity, interest, or talent that is so meaningful they believe their application would be incomplete without it. If this sounds like you, then please share your story.
2. The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?
3. Reflect on a time when you questioned or challenged a belief or idea. What prompted your thinking? What was the outcome?
4. Reflect on something that someone has done for you that has made you happy or thankful in a surprising way. How has this gratitude affected or motivated you?
5. Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.
6. Describe a topic, idea, or concept you find so engaging that it makes you lose track of time. Why does it captivate you? What or who do you turn to when you want to learn more?
7. Share an essay on any topic of your choice. It can be one you've already written, one that responds to a different prompt, or one of your own design.


