TERM 2 MINGLE AND MUNCH

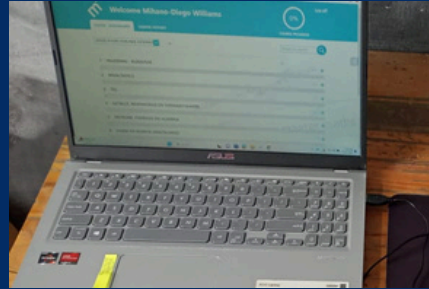
