
Hold this brush near the tip of the handle, and use a gentle sweeping motion to help achieve a light, natural application.



CHEEK BRUSH

Sweep across Mary Kay* Mineral Cheek Color Duo, centering the brush with the shorter bristles over the blush shade and the longer bristles over the highlighter. Then sweep the brush across the cheeks (highlighter at top) to apply blush and highlighter in one stroke.





ALL-OVER EYE SHADOW BRUSH

Apply a small amount of *Mary Kay** Translucent Loose Powder under the eyes to set your look and help prevent smudges throughout the day.



EYE CREASE BRUSH

Trace a V-shape from the outer corners of the eyelids, inward. The point of the "V" should sit at the outer corners, extending just above the creases. Blend only slightly to maintain a graphic design.



Create an attention-grabbing backdrop for lashes, using the pointed tip of this brush to sweep a light shade or a pop of color directly along the upper lashlines.



When using BRIGHT or BOLD Tones for eye shadow, apply with a firm brush and BLEND with a fluffier brush.

fluffy brush can cause the strong pigment to gently drop or flake on the under eye area. To keep all BOLD tones from dusting on your face, use a firm brush (ex. MK Cream Color Brush, Smudger Brush or Crease Brush).

Add liquid foundation directly onto the center of the Liquid Foundation Brush or the back of your hand,

Stipple by lightly tapping on foundation, starting at the center of the face and working outward, or buff foundation by using a circular motion with the brush as you lightly blend to desired coverage.

Place a small amount of Mary Kay* Mineral Powder Foundation into the jar lid. Swirl brush lightly in the powder and tap off excess. Buff mineral powder foundation onto skin in a circular motion, starting at the center of the face and working outward.



THREE TECHNIQUES IN ONE CHEEK BRUSH

- 1. Contour: Place your thumb in the indentation on the Cheek Brush ferrule, and then gently compress the bristles with your fingers. Maintaining a light grip, apply crème-to-powder foundation in the hollows of cheeks, at the jawline and on the sides of the nose. Then release your grip, and use the elongated top bristles to blend.
- 2. Blush: Using the center of the Cheek Brush, apply blush to the apples of your cheeks, holding the brush at a 45-degree angle and blending upwards.
- 3. Highlight: Using the longer bristles of the Cheek Brush, apply highlighter to the tops of cheekbones, bridge of the nose and forehead.



ENDLESS EYE LOOKS

- Sweep eye shadow across the eyelids. Use a light shade to highlight at the brow bones.*
- Starting from the outer corners of the eyes, sweep inward along the creases.
 Or pat or stamp color directly into the creases before blending to diffuse lines.
- Use short, sweeping motions to apply eye color from the outer edges of the upper lashlines, inward. Repeat with lower lashlines.

Add a lighter eye color as a highlight at the inner corners of the eyes.

Use short strokes to softly smudge eyeliner for a smoky effect.*

How to Match Foundation

Skin Tone vs. Undertone

Skin tone is the color of your skin that you can see, which we describe as ivory, beige or bronze. Ivory is the lightest skin color, whereas bronze is the darkest. Your skin tone can change, especially when it is exposed to the sun.

Undertone is the color in your skin that you can't see. This hidden color will determine if your skin is cool, neutral or warm. When skin is described as having cool undertones, it means the skin has more pink and blueish undertones. Skin with warm undertones has more yellow in it. When a person has a neutral undertone, it is a mixture of both warm and cool undertones, and you may not be able to tell which one outweighs the other. Unlike skin tone, undertones do not change.

Additionally, if someone has a skin condition, such as rosacea, it makes her skin tone look pink on the surface. It does not necessarily mean that she has cool undertones. Another thing to remember when identifying undertone is that any skin tone can be cool, warm or neutral. Therefore, you won't always be able to determine someone's undertone just by looking at her, which is why it's important to ask your customer how her skin reacts to the sun. The images below illustrate a range of ivory, beige and bronze and a variety of shades and undertones within those skin tones.

In 3 easy steps identify a customers undertone by asking the following questions:

While in the sun do you:

- 1. Burn easily and hardly/don't tan = if yes most likely pink
- 2. Burn then turn to a tan = if yes most likely warm
- 3. Rarely burn and tan in sun easily = if yes most likely neutral

When using the TimeWise 3D Foundations, you will notice that the same shades in the Matte & Luminous will look like completely different shades.

They are, in fact, the same shades. They actually match to the "T." (I promise you, I've experimented on hundreds of people and am 100% confident that they DO MATCH.)

What happens is...they oxidize at different times. The Matte foundations are more "air-activated," meaning they take a little bit longer to turn to its true shade. Get it on the face as quickly as possible.

Luminous are TRUE TO TONE right out of the tube, and will be a few shades darker than the Matte at FIRST. There's NO oxidizing time needed. Matte will always come out lighter and have a visual color difference of at least 3-4 shades, but will eventually catch up & match to a "T."

Matte needs anywhere from 30 seconds - 1 minute to catch up to Luminous. Oily girls will take 20-30 seconds to come to its truest shade. Drier girls take a bit longer.

Matte absorbs light instead of reflects it. Luminous reflects light.

An easy fix so you don't get flustered trying to wait for the shade to oxidize is to match with Luminous so you can find the shade without having to wait, but obviously if your client's preference is Matte, then give her that shade in the Matte.



If being outdoors and/or tanning is part of a customer's routine, they may need 2 different shades of foundations throughout the year. Also, when someone gets more tan or darker, follow their undertone along the foundation chart to suggest their new shade of foundation.

Covering a Tattoo Using MK Products by International Makeup Artist Lori Hogg


Believe it or not, I get this question A LOT! How do I cover a tattoo? Whether you are helping a bride on her wedding day or someone else who needs their tattoos covered temporarily, I'm going to show you how! I did this video a couple years ago showing how to cover a tattoo using ONLY Mary Kay products.

NOTE: This was before the Undereye Corrector came out, so just switch that out for the #3 Facial Highlighting Pen I talk about in the video.



Products you will need:

- Foundation Primer
- Undereye Corrector
- Creme to Powder Foundation
- Finishing Spray
- Translucent Powder
- Silky Setting Powder Foundation (optional)





To cover a SCAR, apply primer to clean skin. Use a little more than normal focusing on the scar. Let it dry a little. Now use a cotton ball (or loose Q-tip) and dab on top of the primer. Use a small amount of loose powder to set it.

This gives the makeup a little extra to grab onto. Now apply your makeup.

Be extra gentle around the area of the scar so not to move the primer.

Makeup doesn't stick to scars because they are soft and have lost their pores. The primer helps create a texture the foundation or concealer can stick to. No matter the shape, size or color, this should help lessen the appearance of any scar!



CHEEK BRUSH



ROUND FACE

- Elongate. your face by applying contour along your temples, under your cheekbones and along your jawline.
- Sweep on blush at a 45-degree angle from your cheeks toward your temples.
- Apply highlighter to the center of your forehead and the tip of your chin



HEART-SHAPED

- Sweep contour along the corners of your forehead and in the hollows of your cheekbones to emphasize bone structure.
 Add a touch of contour beneath your chin to make it appear softer.
- · Apply blush to the apples of your cheeks.
- Apply highlighter to the center of your forehead and on top of your cheekbones and the center of the chin.



LONG FACE

- Apply contour to the tip of the chin and along hairline to create balance at the longest part of your face.

SQUARE FACE

- Apply contour on both sides of your forehead, along the corners of your jawline and under your cheekbones to elongate your face.

Eye shapes







Eyes that are about one eye width apart.

Apply Shade 1 to the brow bone, Shade 2 on the eyelid, and Shade 3 at the crease. Remember to blend shades seamlessly while maintaining the definition created by the three shades.





Wide-Set Eyes

Eyes that are more than one eye width apart.

To help eyes appear closer together, apply Shade I to the outer brow bone and Shade 2 on the eyelid. Apply Shade 3 to inner corner of the eye instead of the outer corner and extend up to the eye brow. Then apply the same shade to the entire lower lashline.





Close-Set Eyes

Eyes that are less than one eye width apart.

To help the eyes appear further apart, apply Shade 1 to the brow bone and Shade 2 to the eyelid. Apply Shade 3 to the outer corner of the eye in a softly blended triangle shape. Blend the same shade along the outer third of the lower lashline.





Hooded Eye

Eyes with an eyelid that is not readily seen.

To add dimension to the eyes and give the illusion of a deeper eye crease, apply Shade 1 to the eyelid. Apply Shade 3 along the top of the entire length of the eye crease and blend upward almost to the brow. Then apply Shade 2 along the brow bone instead of the eyelid.





Deep-Set Eye

Eyes that are set deep with a prominent brow bone
Apply Shade 3 to the entire eyelid and on the outer third of the lower
lashline. Trace a line from the inner corner of the eye crease to the brow
bone with Shade 2. Apply Shade 1 just above Shade 2 and to the inner
corner of the eye.



Using a highlight on the brow bone that's WAY too light for your skin can make the Brow Bone look puffy and increase the look of hooded eyes. Keeping your highlight skin-toned (Sandcastle is a GREAT choice for beige skin) or going one shade lighter will enhance the eye and minimize the attention to the area! Stay away from shimmer in this area. We do NOT want our brow bone Highlight to be the main feature on the face!



Blue Eyes: Peach toned eye shadows bring out ANY blue eyes! When looking at neutral shadows, go with warmer tones to really set your blue off! If the eye color is more icy blue, stick with cool tones such as purples, soft pinks, pastel tones. If the eye color is more of a deeper blue, royal blue or navy blue, then try a color like Shiny Penny.

Green Eyes: Purples have always been the dominate shadow tones for green eyes. When looking at neutrals, go with a plums or grey browns. Cool neutrals! Green eyes LOVE PINK and red tones like Burnished Bronze/Cinnabar. These tones really set fire to green eyes! Vibrant pinks should be worn with a lighter green eye. Deeper burgundy and reds look so dramatic with a deep green eye.

Brown Eyes: The interchangeable eye! Meaning, the eye color that can wear anything without diluting the color of the eye!Brown eyes LOVE BLUES!! Light blues, dark blues, shimmer blues!! Browns have a tad bit of a warm tone in them so Blue Shadows really pull them out!! Try Midnight Star or Evening Navy

Grey Eyes: follow the rules for Blue eyes

Hazel Eyes: find the dominate color in the hazel and follow above! Use bright bold purples such as Sweet Plum.





Shimmer must be worn in the right areas to truly benefit from the product, just like any products/makeup. It's nothing to be afraid of! A little bit of matte and a little bit of shimmer!

Shimmer is ageless - it can be bold or soft, glamorous or natural.

Shimmer draws attention to the cheeks and eyes, making the skin reflect light which gives off that beautiful shine.

For more Youthful Skin: Shimmer can give a soft, fresh or natural glow to the skin. It can also be used to bump up your glamor look.

Also remember to apply your liner in the lash line, not above the lash line or in the water line.



What to do if your Mascara CONSTANTLY Runs??? by International Makeup Artist Lori Hogg

Here's a few reasons why it happens:

- When we smile, our cheeks come up and run into the coated lashes. We have warm eyelids so it doesn't take much to make this happen!
 - Watery Eyes
 - You don't set your eyeliner!



Here are some quick and EASY ways to correct any and all mascara issues smudging under the eye!

When you line around the eye area, SET IT! Use a tone like Hazelnut, Hot Fudge or Espresso (Onyx for extra depth) to trace back over the eyeliner. This keeps the eyeliner still!

For oily eyelids... First apply the MK Eye Primer as a base for your eye shadows. After ALL eye shadows are on, use an eye crease brush like the MK Classic Crease Brush or <u>LH Large</u> <u>Ultimate Crease Brush</u> and dip into translucent powder. Apply the Translucent Powder over the entire eye area to help absorb future oil! Amazing!!!

Constantly smiling.... is wonderful for the soul! If you feel like your mascara constantly runs when you smile, use waterproof mascara on the bottom lashes and completely eliminate the black pencil liner.

Usually there's not enough mascara on the bottom to get stuck like it can on top. (OR if you're lucky enough to have any of the old brow gel left, you can use that as a final clear coat to keep it in place 100%!)


Step One: Hold the Mary Kay Eyebrow/Eyeliner Brush parallel to the side of your nose. Draw a light line with the Mary Kay Precision Brow Liner to mark your brow starting point

Step Two: Measure from the outer corner of your nose across the iris of your eye to find your natural arch, and draw a light line to this point.

Step Three: Measure from the outer corner of your nose across the outer corner of your eye to find where your brow tail should end. Draw a light line here. Then fill it in!









Create a solid straight line from the very tip of the brow to the peak (no gaps or holes) and fill in the rest of the hairs over top. This will lift the brow and follow the eye socket area, creating the perfect frame for the face.

Basic Lip Look

After prepping lips, allow a few minutes before applying lip color.

Apply lipstick in a shade close to your natural lip tone or one or two shades darker. Start in the middle of the upper lip, sweeping to the corners. Then repeat application on the

bottom lip.

Blot lips after applying lipstick. It will help set the color and remove excess lipstick.

For a bit of shine or to create color combinations, apply lip gloss, following the same steps suggested for lipstick application.















Lip Hacks

Achieve the Perfect Red Lip w/ NO Transfer by International Makeup Artist Lori Hogg

Step One: BEFORE APPLYING FOUNDATION: Use a TINY amount of Oil Mattifier on the lip area. Adding a lip balm may keep your lips super smooth all day, BUT it also creates enough slide for your lipstick to move around! That's a NO NO for today!

Step Two: Apply Foundation ALL over the entire lip area!

Step Three: Find a skin-tone lip liner and/or use the Age-Fighting Lip Primer. By doing this technique, when the Red starts to slowly fade, it will simply look like a lipstick stain (beautiful and natural) compared to a hard outline around your lips with a deeper tone.

Step Four: Find your perfect RED! Ivory tones do best in Pink Reds. Beige tones do best in True Reds or Orange Reds, Bronze do best in Berry Reds!

Step Five: Once you have found your shade of Red, apply in a fine layer with a <u>Lip Brush!</u> After your First Layer..... Get out your Translucent Powder!! Using a small brush (MK Crease Brush gently powder the top and bottom lip. Just enough to matte it down!

Next, APPLY ANOTHER LAYER OF RED! Repeat with the Translucent Powder! Don't be afraid to do this application a few times, the lips will look very full with a velvet effect!











One of the WORST mistakes we make as women is doing TOO much to the Eyes AND Lips! Let's play up ONE feature at a time. If you're going for a SUPER BOLD Lip (like this one). Soften the eyes!

I a still on the hunt for a Real Esgal and I thought you would perfect for it since I've follow you for so long! Would you be offended if I asked you to be featured in my portfolio? I located on the south side of Pueblo!

I would be honored! Thank you so much for asking and congrats on your endeavors! Anything I can do to help!

Booking Script:

Hey Alyssa © quick question- I teach skin care & makeup in the area & I am building a new women's [before/after etc] portfolio so I am in the process of finding some local women to feature in my portfolio and I thought you would be perfect for it [because you have such good skin, pretty eyes, etc] Would you be offended if I asked you to be featured in my portfolio? ♥

*when they say yes book time and date - THEN ask them to have a friend join etc"

Great! I am also on the lookout for a couple more women to add to my portfolio. Do you happen to know 1-2 friends that may want to join you and I can feature them too?!

I always ask them to come with a clean face! This way we can do skincare on half the face. If she can't come with no makeup on then we do skincare on the whole face!

Opening the Appointment:

I love to teach my customers that their makeup will only look as good as their skin is. Today we will be focusing on your "before" picture for your appointment! I want to teach you all about prepping your skin so that when we customize your makeup it is a flawless finish in your "after" picture! 

Clean Your Makeup Routine...

Mascara - Replace every 3 months. Once it's opened, oxygen affects the mascara & it starts to collect bacteria.

Eyeliner - Liquid or pencil eyeliners should be replaced every 3 months. Pencils should be sharpened before each use to clean and preserve them.

Foundation - Unopened, 2-3 years, but once opened, replace every 6-12 months.

Lipstick/Gloss - Replace after 1 year. Don't share lip products and dispose if they become dry or change color.

Liquid Concealer - after 1 yr

Eyeshadows- every 2 vears

Cheek Colors- every 2 years

Powders - up to 3 years

Products with SPF or acne medication - check exp date
