- On your Costume Bag is a Hair & Makeup template, this is a guide to follow. This will be easy, when using
  makeup on young skin applying powder on the face will soften the glow of the lights and protect the skin. Makeup
  is removed easily with baby oil or wipes designed for makeup removal.
- Check the Hair template. Most student's hair must be slicked back out of their faces. This is easily achieved: wet
  hair, put in hair gel, and put the hair in a ponytail if need be. Follow with hair spray and set with a warm hair dryer.
   Please refer to the makeup template for another style of hair that fits their character.
- Remember that you must **RETURN the COSTUME IN THE COSTUME BAG** the night of the performance.
