

Snow White Important Dates & Rehearsal/Costume/Hair/Make-up and Tickets

Wow!!! We are getting close to performance time and the students have been working hard to bring you a truly great show. Your children have been learning so much during their rehearsals. During their journey these past months, they have learned commitment, time management, teamwork, creativity, self-expression and so much more!
Being in a Theatre Arts production is such a valuable learning experience, and we are lucky to have a program like this one in the Litchfield district when so many elementary students have no access to performing-arts opportunities. Important/mandatory dates

March 30th Tuesday - 6pm-7:30 Dress Rehearsal (full costume & make up)
at Litchfield Elementary Stage best place to park/drop off is the parking lot across from the Wigwam.

April 1st Wednesday- 6pm-7:30 Dress Rehearsal (full costume)
at Litchfield Elementary Stage best place to park/drop off is the parking lot across from the Wigwam.

April 4th Saturday- SHOW - All cast at 5:00pm (full costume & make up)
at Litchfield Elementary Stage best place to park/drop off is the parking lot across from the Wigwam.

PARENTS are not allowed to come in till 6:00pm! On April 4th (please be patient)

****Your child will be getting nervous about the Performance,
give them encouragement and make sure their lines are memorized and to not miss any rehearsals.***

Tickets

- You will be getting a ticket envelope - \$5 a seat
- Fill out the envelope and include money and return ASAP!
- You will pick up your tickets at the table by the front of the door the night of the performance.
- Additional Tickets will be on sale the night of the performance for \$7.
- Students are free if they sit on the floor Quietly in front of the stage.

Costume Bag

- Take good care of your costume - and do not lose it!
- You may add to your costume, but I reserve the right to veto changes.
- Use makeup. Foundation and or powder on the face will soften the glow of the lights.
And protect young skin. Makeup removes easily with baby oil or wipes designed for makeup removal.
- All students' hair must be slicked back out of their faces. This is easily achieved: wet hair, put in hair gel (it need not be costly or fancy!) and put the hair in a ponytail if need be. Follow with hair spray and set with a warm hair dryer.
- Remember that you need to **RETURN the COSTUME BAG** the night of the performance. (Don't forget to bring a change of clothes!)
