ADRIA CONNECTION GATHERING

Similar to that happening in biblical history, this April a group of like-minded conservative Methodist believers from Europe came together



with partners from the GMC in America. We worshiped, discussed together in brotherly union, and prayed for the future vision of the churches in Europe. This was the second gathering under the name "Adria Connection", and the main topic of this gathering was: "How can we organize a solid theological education in Europe?" Representatives from our partner institutions Asbury Seminary and United Theological Seminary provided many helpful ideas in that regard. Encouraged by this event, we are already making plans to organize a similar gathering next Fall in one of the other European Methodist churches.

NEW CHURCH FACILITY IN ZAGREB DEDICATED

I am pleased to report that our church in Zagreb is now able to hold worship in our new facility – that we now fully own! This is huge progress for us, since we no longer have a mortgage to pay on any more. We are thankful for all our supporters who, by their gifts, helped us to build this new GMC headquarters for the church and mission in Croatia.

The opening Dedication Ceremony was held on May 12th. It was a festive event that was well attended. A small choir blessed us by singing old church hymns and we had a joyful fellowship



together. This new facility represents a good restart of the Methodist presence in the city of Zagreb. It is larger, so we are now able to accommodate more people at our services. There

is still some construction work to be done, such as the kitchen and on the exterior of the building. So please pray that we are able to finish this work soon.

UPDATES ON CHRISTIAN ADVOCACY

In the Spring and Summer, representatives of the Church were invited as guests in the Parliament of Croatia. In May, Pastor Vatroslav met with the parliament representative Marijana Petir. She is known as someone who cares for the protection of Christian values and stands for the rights of persecuted Christians around the world. In July, our lay leader Martina Lukić was invited to about the religious rights of Christians today. In a secularistic Europe there are more and more obstacles for churches and believers to overcome. Mrs. Lukić has openly presented the view that the Church supports public prayer and that Judeo-Christian values must be protected and promoted if we are to have a stable, righteous and healthy society.

Because of our openly pro-Israel stance during the difficult time in Israel, Pastor Vatroslav was invited to the Embassy of the State of Israel. Israeli
