

Sample Score Card

The “Round” column also represents the number of cards dealt for each round

- Gracyn is chosen to deal for the first round. Dave bids first (left of dealer). Player’s initials are placed in the Dealer column clockwise from first dealer
- Round one shows two players bidding “1”, meaning one player will not get their bid since there is only one trick available in round 1
- Scoring results as marked for round 1 (one trick available)
 - Dave receives 1 point for his trick plus 10 totaling 11 points total
 - Kris, Marv, Sawyer, and Gracyn receive 10 points each for bidding zero and not taking a trick
 - Beth receives zero points due to not taking one trick to match her bid
- Scoring results as marked for round 2 (two tricks available)
 - Notice the total number of bids is more than the total available tricks
 - Dave receives 10 additional points for making his bid of zero totaling 21 points
 - Kris and Gracyn did not take a trick, therefore, they did not make their bid, scores remain the same
 - Marv and Beth receive an additional 10 points each for making their bids of zero
 - Sawyer made her bid of 2, adding 12 points to her round one score, totaling 22 points
- Scoring results as marked for round 3 (three tricks available, notice the total bid is less than 3)
 - Dave receives 1 point for his trick, plus 10, 11 points total, totaling 32 at the end of round 3
 - Kris, Marv, and Gracyn receive 10 additional points each for making their bid of zero
 - Beth took the extra available trick that she did not bid on, therefore, earning zero points
 - Sawyer receives 11 points for making her bid of 1, adding 11 points, now totaling 33 in round 3
 - This recording of scores continues for each round until the game ends. ©2017
