

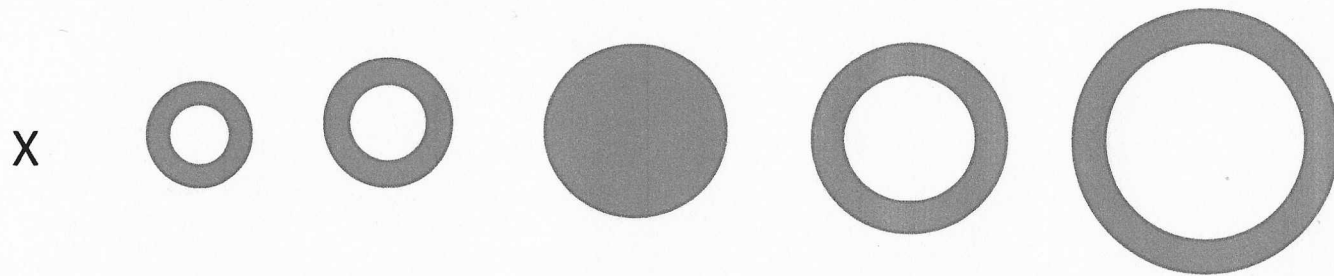
## Pain Rx Effectiveness – Patient scoring:

Score Your Pain: A. When Rx should be peak effective.

B. When it is time for next Rx dose.

Solid circle is your pain level when you **last took medication** for it.

Which circle is your pain **now**:

	Pain Level = Need Meds!		(typically over the counter NSAID)		
0	2.4	3.6	4= Same	4.5	5.7
	Pain Level = Needs Stronger Medicine! (typically Rx drug or alt. treatment)				
0	4.4	5.6	6= Same	6.5	7.7
	Pain Level = Meds Not Working! (needs custom pain relief solutions)				
0	6.4	7.6	8= Same	8.5	9.7
	Pain Level = Need Escape! (needs help NOW)				
0	8.4	9.6	10=Same	10.5	11.7
