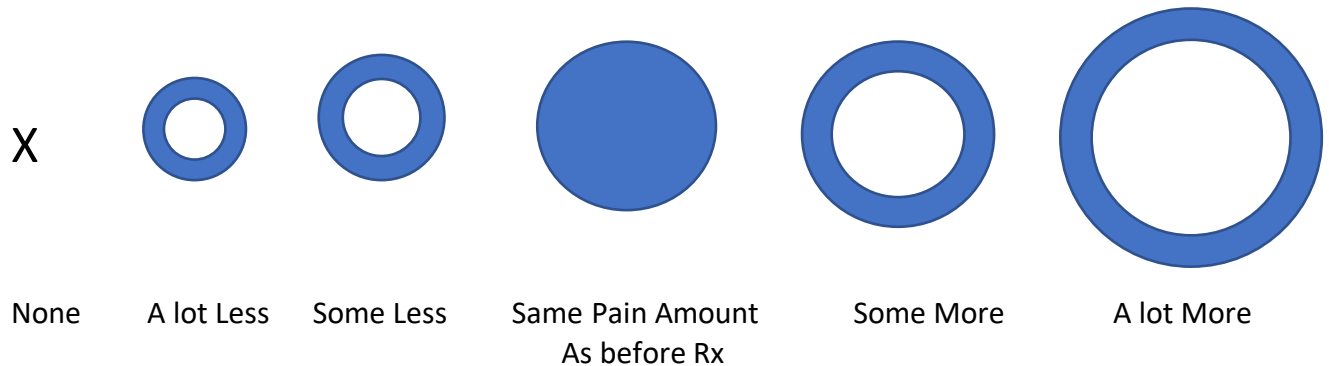


Pain Rx Effectiveness – Patient scoring:

Solid circle is your pain level at the time you last took medication for it.
Which circle is your pain level now:



MPAS+ 5 level scale to standard of 10 points with interpretation of patient pain management needs:

MPAS+ Level 2 = Need Meds! (common NSAID)

0 2.5 3.5 4= Same 4.5 5.5

MPAS+ Level 3 = Needs Stronger Medicine! (typically Rx drug or alt. treatment)

0 4.5 5.5 6= Same 6.5 7.5

MPAS+ Level 4 = Meds Not Working! (requires custom pain relief solutions)

0 6.5 7.5 8= Same 8.5 9.5

MPAS+ Level 5 = Need Escape!

0 8.5 9.5 10=Same 10.5 11.5

A. Measure when Rx should be fully effective.

B. Measure again when Rx effect should be dissipated.

Use with remedy-based pain scale to give 10 scale rating.
