

Order to Cease and Desist

My Private association is providing services to association members as a matter of private contractual obligation and remains entirely outside of the jurisdiction of any government agency to interfere with. It is long settled law that states that “no state can pass any law to impair the obligation of contract” and it is also long settled case law that reinforces my right to conduct any activity as a matter of private contract. See Hale V Henkel (1906) and numerous other long-standing cases. These activities remain entirely outside of the jurisdiction of any government entity or agency to regulate or interfere with as, a matter of private contract, as long as the association is not engaging in “public business” or in activities which “create a clear and present danger of a substantial evil”, which is activity that creates an immediate threat of serious harm or death.

My unincorporated association is also structured as a faith-based organization and has all rights to all manner of religious and faith-based protections, including the separation of church and state and prohibits government from requiring license or imposing regulation. Although licensing requirements may be imposed in an incorporated church (since corporations are creatures of the state), licensing and other regulation CANNOT be imposed upon an unincorporated Church, Church Association, Ministry, or Faith-based organization operating as a private contractual matter. We are governed by our ecclesiastical law.

Your agents have attempted to infringe upon, and even deny our rights and our religious freedoms and you are hereby notified to cease and desist all attempts to interfere with the internal business and activities of our Faith-based Private Membership Association. Failure to adhere to this Cease-and-Desist Demand may result in all trespassers to be held liable civilly, both in their private and public capacities. We retain all rights to pursue civil litigation for actual damages, damages to the reputation of our Association, and punitive damages in accordance with law.
