The Low-Income Housing Coalition of Alabama, in partnership with the National Low Income Housing Coalition, is launching a Tenant Leaders Cohort to advocate for and strengthen housing rights for renters across the state.

What is the tenant leaders cohort?

The tenant leaders cohort is a network of tenants from across Alabama who will work closely with the Low Income Housing Coalition of Alabama (LIHCA) to amplify their lived experience, highlight key concerns, and drive advocacy. Through this initiative, tenants will organize to protect and strengthen the housing rights of low-income individuals and families. The cohort will work to advance tenant protections, focusing on issues such as arbitrary evictions, rent increases, and housing discrimination, with the goal of empowering renters and promoting housing stability statewide.

Tenant Leaders Cohort Goals:

- Establishing a tenant-led organization
- · Identifying the existing tenant protections and gaps
- Prioritizing key areas for strengthening tenant protections
- Increasing advocacy work and engaging with lawmakers
- Developing one legislative proposal

Who is eligible to apply?

Tenants from across Alabama are encouraged to apply for this advocacy initiative. Multiple leaders from the same county are welcome to apply and participate as cohort members.

What is provided?

- A six-month program focused on advocacy training, strategic organizing, and strengthening a network of tenant leaders.
- A mix of virtual and in-person training, complemented by personalized guidance and extensive resources to support the development of the Tenant Leaders Cohort.
- Incentives and compensation to recognize and support tenant leaders for their time and contributions.
