

Arizona Officer Craig Tiger Act (CTA)

Eligibility Overview

The Officer Craig Tiger Act is an Arizona law that requires certain public employers to provide employer-paid mental health counseling to eligible public safety employees following qualifying critical incidents.

Who Is Covered

Peace officers, firefighters, and 911 dispatchers employed by Arizona cities, towns, counties, and other political subdivisions.

Who Is Not Covered

Indian tribes and tribal entities are sovereign governments and are not subject to Arizona state employment laws unless they voluntarily opt in. Private ambulance and EMS companies are private employers and are not required to provide CTA benefits.

Municipal / County Fire, Police, Dispatch	Yes
Indian Tribes / Tribal Governments	No
Private Ambulance / EMS Companies	No
