WHAT WE EXPECT FROM PLAYERS

- Eligibility- Follow the Riverview Athletic Code and maintain eligibility.
- Class-/Do what is right in all settings, including school, community, and at home
- Sportsmanship- We expect our players to respect the game, the officials, and their opponents.
- Commitment- Players will come to each practice with a TEAM first attitude and learn the skills needed to help the team.
- Responsibility- Players will take care of and return their equipment.
- Communication- Let coaches know when there is a problem, injury, or schedule conflict.
- Effort- Effort requires no talent and is always expected.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FROM OUR COACHES

- Teach the game with a positive attitude, and provide clear expectations.
- Treat each player with respect.
- Be accountable for their actions and use appropriate language.
- Put overall team and program goals in front of wins and losses.
- Communicate effectively and as quickly as possible on schedule changes.
- Be respectful of others' time, including starting and ending practice on time.

WHAT WE EXPECT OF PARENTS

- Have a positive attitude towards their child's participation in our program
- Be respectful to other players, teams, coaches, and officials
- Bring any concerns directly to the head coach of the team your child participates on, in a private conversation, at least 24 hours after a game
- Communicate with coaches if your child will be missing a game or practice as soon as possible
- Meet the volunteer requirements for the season
- Encourage your child to work hard during practice and put the goals of the team before their own
- Understand our coaches are doing the best they can, as volunteers, and give them the respect and gratitude they deserve
- Be respectful of others' time. Ensure your child is on time for practice and be there to pick your child up from practice on time as well.
