### **What is the Young Entrepreneur Booth (YEB)?**

### **Who can participate?**

### **How much does it cost?**

### **When and where is the market?**

The Backyard Farmers Market will run for 19 weeks starting May 23rd to October 10th, 2020 on Saturday's only. There will be NO markets on the 4th of July weekend and Festival weekend August 15th.
