FINALS AWARDS

The top 3 in each class will be awarded a plaque. Places 4th through 10th in the Youth class will receive place ribbons.

Rules and Regulations

General Rules

- All shooters must report to the check-in desk 15 minutes before their scheduled shooting time.
- You must be available for Sunday's final shoot-off, otherwise you will forfeit your place.
- Rangefinders are permitted.
- All shooters have a maximum of 1 minute to shoot their arrow once they step up to their designated station marker.
- All arrow points must be screw in style field/practice points.
- All fixed pins must not be moved after the shooters first shot.
- In each group of shooters, there will be 2 shooters as designated scorers.
- All scoring will be following the IBO scoring standards.
 - An "11" ring consisting of a circle centered within the 10 ring.
 - A 10 ring consisting of a circle inside the vital area.
 - A vital area (8 ring) that roughly approximates the heart, lung, and liver area of the appropriate animal.
 - The remainder of the animal shall be considered a "body" except as set out in the paragraph below.
 - An arrow embedded in the horn of an animal, not touching body color, is considered a miss and is scored as a zero. Targets with legs or hooves of a different color than the main body will still be considered as body color for scoring.
 - Some targets have material surrounding the actual outline of a target animal. This additional material will NOT be counted for score.

Regulations

Men's Open:

- No restrictions, EXCEPT no lock backs.

Men's Bowhunter:

- No limit on the number of stabilizers. Each stabilizer must not exceed 12 inches of length from the point of attachment to the bow. This includes any quick disconnect or any other type of additional attachment the stabilizer must "connect" to in order to be connected to the bow.
- Must use a fixed pin sight. A clarifier in the peep sight is permitted.

Women's Open:

- No restrictions, EXCEPT no lock backs.

Youth Open:

- No restrictions, EXCEPT no lock backs.
- Each youth shooter is allowed to have 1 adult accompany them on the shooting line. The accompanying adult can only tell the youth shooter which is the correct target to shoot at. **ABSOLUTELY NO COACHING BY THE ACCOMPANYING ADULT.**
