

WLDEF Scholarship Fund

2024 - 2025 School Year

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The applicant must live in Wisconsin or Upper Michigan, and enrolling in a program that centers on, or supports, the lumber and building materials industry, the building trades or in small business management. The applicant must be applying to or been accepted by a two or four-year college, university, or accredited vocational program. Awards are contingent upon verification of enrollment in such a school as a full-time student. Previous scholarship applicants may reapply.

Scholarship awards are for one year in the amount of \$4,000 each, payable at \$2,000 per semester. Second semester awards are contingent upon passing grades for the first semester.

This application and all supporting materials must be postmarked by March 1, 2024 and received by the committee to be eligible for consideration. Scholarship winners will be notified in April.

Applications and attachments may not be sent by fax.

The program will pay scholarship awards directly to the school upon verification of enrollment. The award must be applied to tuition, room, or board for the student.

An eligible candidate:

- Must live in Wisconsin or Michigan Upper Peninsula
- Must be enrolling in a program that centers on, or supports, the lumber and building materials industry, the building trades, or in small business management.
- Will be attending an accredited two-year or four-year school of higher education or an accredited vocational school as a full-time student.
- Will have a high school diploma or equivalent by August 1, 2024.

SELECTION PROCESS

Selection criteria include: academic achievements, extracurricular activities, financial need and future goals.

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

You must attach TWO (2) letters of recommendation as follows:

- One from a principal, teacher or counselor at the school you are presently attending or, if you are not presently in school, the school most recently attended.
- One from a person of your choice, other than family member, who knows you well from school, work, church or other contact, such as a employer, coach, pastor, etc.
