- Attendee must complete the class. Qualified LumberTech classes include: Estimating 123; Blueprint Reading & Material Take-off, Sales Development Workshop, Yard & Delivery Workshop, Lumberyard Design Workshop, and Returns, Refunds and Special Order Policies.

Upon verification of full payment and attendance at the class, WLDEF will process your request. Tuition assistance payments will only be paid to a member company. No payments will be made to an individual attendee.

WLDEF reserves the right to decline any assistance request that does not meet all criteria. Webinars and BLD Connection convention and conference seminars are excluded from this program.
