CBSE Cluster XIV Kabaddi Championship (Boys & Girls) U-17 & U-19 2018-19 1st - 3rd October, 2018

Important Instructions, Rules and Regulation for Participating Schools

1. Every affiliated school shall be entitled to enter its athlete/team in the CBSE Sports and Games Competitions. As soon as Calendar is uploaded on the Board's website, the schools may fill-in the online discipline-wise Entry Proformae.
2. No school will be permitted to participate unless they fill the online discipline-wise Entry Proformae and by-hand Entry Proformae would not be accepted.
3. No team will be permitted to play unless accompanied by a teacher/coach at the venue.
4. All expenses on items like travel, food, kit etc will have to be borne by the participating School.
5. Dining in the mess arranged by the host school is mandatory for the teams that opt to stay in the school provided accommodation.
6. Every player/athlete/team shall carry with them the required documents as mentioned under title "Eligibility".
7. Every team will carry their school flag, for the purpose of March past and to be used during the various ceremonies. Participation in March past is compulsory, failing which their right to participate can be forfeited.
8. Organising School will not provide food & transport facility to school/teams making their own stay arrangements.
9. It is the responsibility of the school/teams staying outside, to collect information in regard to matches/fixtures/program etc.
10. Any non-designated person accompanying the team will not be entertained for any matter at the venue and will not be permitted to stay in the premises.
11. In case the player/team is being accompanied only by the parent, it should be informed by the Principal of participating school in writing.
12. Kabaddi being a body contact sports, there are chances of injuries, therefore if any player gets any injury, the organising school will not be responsible for it.

Lodging and Boarding Charges and Refund Policy:

- The boarding charges will be Rs.350/- per head per day including bedding charges.

- It is advised that from the health and safety point of view, all participating teams dine in the mess arranged by the Organizing school.
- The championship is being held on knock out basis and the organizing and participating schools will collect/deposit payments against meals on full day basis and no part payment will be collected/deposited and the participating schools will not insist for refund of part payment.
- The teams returning shall be eligible for refund of payment deposited, but only for the post 24 hours balance meal coupons.

ACCREDITED REPRESENTATIVES (TEACHER/COACH/MANAGER)

1. All the teams shall be accompanied by a Teacher/Coach/Manager designated by the participating school Principal.
2. No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying official.
3. No team shall be accompanied by any parent. However if a parent is accompanying the team, such information may be provided by the school on the school letterhead.
4. No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.
5. In case of Girls participants, one of the accompanying officials must be a female.
6. **The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid Identity Card issued by their school Principal.**

COLOURS

1. All the participating teams shall compete in the Inter-School tournament in their respective playing uniform with the prescribed color of their school and numbered.
2. In case of clash of playing jersey color, it shall be decided by the spin of coin as to which team will have to change playing uniform.

ENTRIES

1. As soon as the Sports Calendar has been uploaded, it becomes the responsibility of the schools to fill in the entry proforma online.
2. Each school shall be entitled to enter only one team or individual for each tournament/meet/event.
3. A junior player can be permitted to play in senior age group, and then the participation in the original group will be forfeited.
4. Soon after filling -in the entry proforma, schools should make travel bookings and send the information to the Organizing school for making the necessary arrangements.
5. **Whatever the reason may be, on the spot entry and late entry will not be entertained.**

WITHDRAWING SCHOOL

1. If a school, after filling-in its entry, wishes to withdraw from a tournament/meet, it shall give a written request of its intention to do so to the Organizing Secretary/School.
2. School withdrawing without informing/requesting the Organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty or Rs.1000/-.

ELIGIBILITY

A. Age:

The athlete/player should be within the particular age group on 31 December of the year of competition.

- Only bonafide students shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-School tournaments/meets. Feeding any non bonafide student shall lead to disqualification of the team.
- A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate.
- Incomplete information in any respect is liable for disqualification of team.
- Any violation in eligibility (over age or Impersonation) shall be dealt according to rules.
- Medical check up may also be applied by the Jury of Appeal appointed by the Organizing school in the cases of overage suspicion.
- A player shall be under 17 & 19 years of age on 31 Dec 2018.

1. Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2002
2. Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2000

- All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player, etc in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines & Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/Coach while reporting for participation.
- The player's right to participate forfeits if fails to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.
- Any team/athlete not fulfilling the eligibility criteria before the commencement of the tournament/meet shall not be permitted to participate.

B. Weight

The competition shall be governed and played as per the prevailing rules:

Under 17: for girls [below 55 Kg weight] & boys [below 60 Kg weight] under 17 years age category at leveled & soft-surface.

Under 19: for girls [below 60 Kg weight] & boys [below 65 Kg weight] under 19 years age category at leveled & soft-surface.

IMPORTANT:

IT SHALL BE MANDATORY FOR ALL THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING ON ARRIVAL AT VENUE-

- (i) The documents for verification in original if asked for.
- (ii) The team photo with school Principal along with the entry Performa, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
- (iii) To provide CBSE registration number for student/player studying in class IX and above.
- (iv) To supply the eligibility performa filled-in online, countersigned by the concerned Principal.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

A player/team may be disqualified/scratched for the following reasons.

1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
2. Inclusion of non bonafide student in the team.
3. Misbehavior on ground by athlete or accompanying official.
4. Use of abusive language by athlete or accompanying official.
5. Misbehavior with Officials/Opponents by athlete or accompanying official.
6. Indiscipline at the place of stay by athlete or accompanying official.
7. Damaging the school property.
8. Indiscipline during the Opening and Closing ceremonies by athlete or accompanying official.
9. Non participation in March Past.
10. Not reporting on time

The Organizing School in no case shall show the eligibility performa or any other paper of a team to anyone who lodges the protest. It is only the jury of appeals prerogative to verify all the documents.
