

Ring Sizing Chart



STOP! Please read the instructions completely before ordering your ring.

INSTRUCTIONS

Print this page at 100%. Make sure your printer is not set to print to fit etc.

Once you have printed this page measure this sample to confirm the page was printed at 100%.

This black bar should measure 1.5" (one and a half inches).

PREFERRED SIZING METHOD

1. Find a piece of non-stretchy string about 6" long, or a strip of paper about 6" long and 1/4" wide.
2. Wrap it snugly around the base of your finger.
3. Using a pen, mark the point on the string or paper where it overlaps, forming a complete circle.
4. Compare the length of the string or paper to the lines on the paper below to determine your ring size.
If you are between sizes, order the larger size.

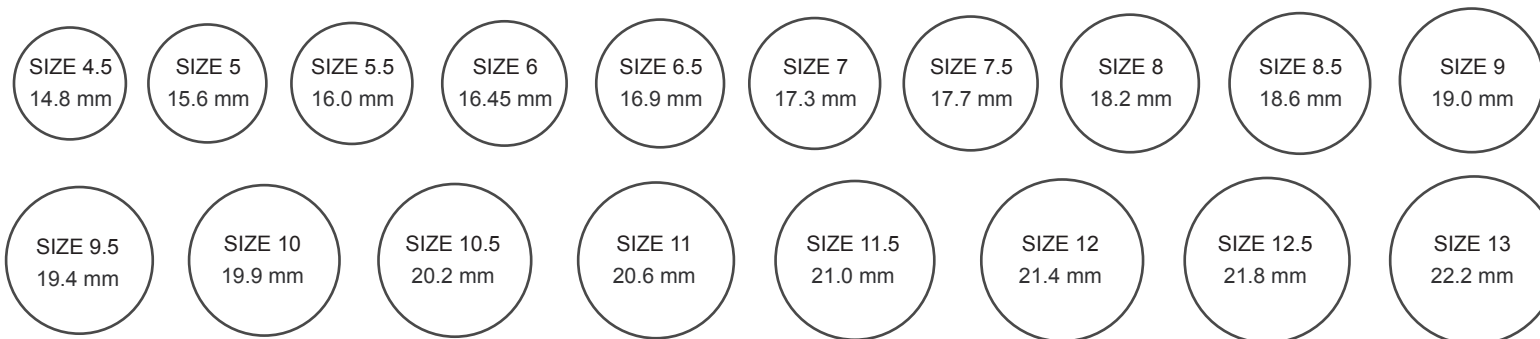

EXISTING RING SIZING METHOD

1. Place a ring that fits you over the circle making sure the inside of the ring lines up with the outside of the circle.
If you are between sizes, order the next size up.
