June 10, 2024**

The Galatia Village Board of Trustees met for their regular scheduled meeting on June 10 2024, at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Steve Sloan presiding. Motion made by Stevens and seconded by Higgins to approve minutes of May 13, 2024, regular meeting. Roll call vote: Ayes 6 Nays 0. Motion carried.

Motion made by Campbell and seconded by Bond to pay the monthly bills for June. Roll call vote: Ayes 6 Nays 0. Motion carried.

Motion made by Fletcher and seconded by Stevens to approve the May Treasurer's Report. Roll call vote: Ayes 6 Nays 0. Motion carried.

Motion made by Higgins and seconded by Stevens to approve State Revolving Fund Notification and Application for Construction Permit. Roll call vote: Ayes 6 Nays 0. Motion carried.

Board discussion regarding Letter from Attorney Smithpeters on the ambulance service and billing. Board tabled the issue until more information is received from City of Harrisburg.


Board discussion regarding sewer issues with the car wash. Further research into the issue will be done.

Board discussion regarding purchasing a new pump and check valve at the sewer plant. Board decided this is a required purchase.

Board discussion regarding 4-Wheelers, Side by Sides and Golf Carts. Board decided to leave Ordinance that is currently in place as is but in discussion with Sheriff Johnson tickets will be issued for underaged drivers and careless driving. Sheriff suggested the Village put out a public notice on social media to advise residents of Galatia of this issue and possible citations and fines.
