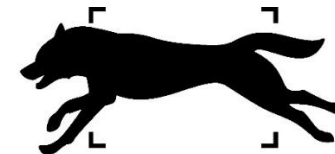
Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely. Missouri Rhineland Kennel Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Obedience or Rally Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before the trial commences. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Exhibitors are responsible for being ready for judging when called to the ring. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Missouri Rhineland Kennel Club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required. Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must complete back of form. Include only AKC titles on entries. All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC event. The dog's breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC events. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee. No refunds will be issued for overpayments of less than \$10. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) at the show site and at all hotels, motels, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials. Missouri Rhineland Kennel Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event. Missouri Rhineland Kennel Club, its Board and Members, and Nestlé Purina Farms and its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

NO SMOKING or VAPING is permitted in Purina Event Center. Weapons of any kind, illegal drugs and fireworks are not permitted on the premises. The arena is air-conditioned with indoor restrooms. Please bring crates and water for your dogs and clean up supplies. Ex-pens are permitted. **ALL CRATES MUST BE ON A MAT.**

All dogs must be on leash held by a exhibitor or crated at all times except when in the ring. Warm-up must be done on lead. No Flexis leads allowed.

Trial Information Setup information will be sent after closing Trial hours are 7:30 am to 30 minutes after the trial in completed. Trials will be held consecutively on Friday and Saturday. Please bring crates and water for your dogs and clean up supplies. No outside food or beverage is allowed on Purina Farms property. Violators will be reported to the AKC. No exhibitors shall be in the building before or after show hours.

- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been made to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All American Dog/Mixed Breed". Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
