Hotel/Dog Show Guidelines

When you sign the show entry form, you automatically agree to the following terms concerning motels. They have been established for the good of all exhibitors and will ensure future use of these facilities.

- 1. Maximum 4 dogs per room.
- 2. Dogs left unattended in a guest room MUST be in a crate. Plastic sheeting MUST be under each crate in the guest room.
- Hotel guests with dogs in the room need to use the special door hanger provided by the hotel. This
 hanger will leave instructions to the housekeeping staff. Housekeeping will not enter the room unless
 the door hanger is present.
- 4. Housekeeping must be allowed to INSPECT a guest room (with dogs) daily. Guests who have special request (e.g. a certain time of the day that room will be vacant) can discuss them with the housekeeping staff upon arrival.
- 5. Bathing and/or grooming of dogs in or outside the guest room is not allowed. HOLIDAY INN has a grooming house on the grounds which will be available for use. The hotel does provide some towels to the grooming area. Grooming is not allowed on any sidewalks.
- 6. The individual guest will be responsible for any damages to a guest room or any hotel property. This includes, but is not limited to replacement cost of carpeting if odors or stains cannot be removed by traditional cleaning methods. Damage claims must be settled on the spot.
- 7. Dogs are to be on leash at all times when out of the guest room.
- 8. The hotel and the show committee will investigate any problem areas that are outlined above. Any guest not following the above guidelines will be asked to check out of the hotel without refund.

4 pts. Qualifying Advanced Score

Dogs receiving qualifying scores in performance events will be awarded 2, 3, or 4 points as appropriate for their class but do not receive the participation point as well. The Participation point in performance events is awarded only if the dog competes but does not qualify in the event. Dogs competing in multiple classes at the same event will be credited with the highest placement received in any one

Dogs that make a cut or earn placements and awards in breed competition will be awarded 2, 3, or 4 points as applicable to the award, but do not receive the participation point as well. Dogs who make multiple cuts in a class will receive the same two points as dogs that make one cut. Dogs excused from the breed ring shall still be awarded a point for participation. Dogs disgualified from the breed ring shall not be awarded a point for participation.

Preferred agility classes are scored equally to the corresponding regular agility class. Non-regular obedience classes are scored as the regular class with similar or next lower difficulty level. For example, Veterans obedience qualifying score is worth 2 pt. because Novice exercises are used. Beginner Novice qualifying score is worth only the one point for participation because exercises are less difficult than Novice. Graduate Novice qualifying score is Worth 2 pt. because it is similar to Novice and less difficult than Open. 2019 is a test year or Premier and it will no Partial points will not be awarded. In the event of a tie, event scores shall be used to break the tie. The dog with the highest total score will receive the award. The official catalog markings taken from the judges' books.

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

The AKC will collect a \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee for each entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Event/Recording Fees will be collected on each entry.

- Please note: Rally is considered a separate trial from obedience.
- At every licensed or member club Rally Trial, a Recording Fee of \$3.50 shall be required for the entry of each dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3).
- A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for the AKC.
- Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. Accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated
 to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or agents of Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any
 dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of dogs in the judging
 rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, E-mail and
 unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms, and
 Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT
 ACCEPTABLE. The club and/or its Superintendent assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete
 information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. Responsibility for
 completeness of any entry rests solely with entrant.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by
 the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it
 has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for duplicate entries or overpayments. The
 Superintendent/Secretary will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been
 processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the
 control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the show, NO REFUND will be
 made.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent/Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- Refunds for cancellations due to judge change or cancellation made prior to entries closing will be
 mailed to said exhibitor or agent after the show.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgement and judging program to
 address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgement within a reasonable time,
 PLEASE notify the Secretary/Superintendent applicable to the specific trial as noted in the premium list.
- Loss or Damage: The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and
 exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or
 misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is



The Importance of Form and Function for the Performance Prospect

Seminar – <u>Saturday, March 19, 2022, to follow the Obedience / Rally trials</u> - brought to you by Cheryl Sacerich, Nancy Runyon, Ashley Corbin Wooten, Penny Brcich, Lisa Schwartzenbert and a bunch of Shelties.

The conformation and bone structure of the Shetland Sheepdog is important to the performance handler. Does your Sheltie have a proper front and rear? Do you struggle with the concept of straight shoulders? Don't get confused when you hear the word "conformation", it is not just an event, it is the structure and the most important thing you will ever learn about your dog.

The front, consisting of the shoulders and the front legs, provides the lift, the direction and the landing. The rear, consisting of the back legs and pelvic area, provide that forward movement. Join us for a hands-on evaluation into the importance of the structure when picking your next performance puppy. If you struggle with the concept of straight shoulders, the hands-on approach might clarify it for you. We will be looking at how the front-end assembly balances the rear, and how that impacts your performance sport.



Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- · Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
