Showcase

Again, this year, MASCUSA will be honoring the AKC TOP 10 MACH and PACH Miniature American Shepherds in a showcase event that will start after the conclusion of runs in the JWW Ring, Ring 2 Monday, 5/18. Please plan to watch and cheer for these great handler teams.

Premier Teams Challenge

Premier teams challenge is open to any pair of Handler/Dog teams. A team is comprised of two handlers and two dogs. A dog can only compete on one team. A handler can be on more than one team. Teams can be mixed height and a mixture of regular and preferred. Scores will be calculated using time plus faults across all premier runs (2 each day). The top 10 teams will participate in the Final Teams relay that will take place at the conclusion of day 2. Awards will be given to the top 4 teams. Cost is \$20 per dog to enter. All funds raised will benefit the MASCUSA junior fund. You can pay for your team the first day of the trial. **To enter, please send an email to David Yaste, d.yaste@comcast.net or enter the first day of the trial.**

Note: The standard ring will have priority if you have conflicts between rings, meaning run your dog as scheduled in the standard ring, reflect conflicts in the JWW ring. This does not mean you cannot spread your dogs out in

the standard ring if you are running multiple dogs. You may walk with an earlier group if needed. You must run within your walk group!

Move Ups:

Move Ups: For the 5/18 trial – move ups close at 6pm on Monday, May 11th, 2026. **Please note that this is a specific AKC regulation – if you trial the weekend in between May 11th and May 18th, you WILL NOT be able to move up for the Monday May 18th trial date.** For the Tuesday trial: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Monday and must be submitted at the trial.

Measuring

If your dog is under 2 years old and has never been measured, or if your dog has turned 2 years old and has not been measured – it needs to be measured before your first run of the day by one of the judges. This measurement will only be valid for this trial. To our knowledge, there will not be a VMO onsite.

Crating

The building will be open each morning at 6:30 am for crating. Mats or tarps are required under all crates. Please crate only in designated areas.

Food
