### **Routes to the Show Site**

**From the East**: I-70 West to Exit 208. Turn left at the end of the ramp, then cross bridge and at light turn right onto the South Service Road. Turn Left on Swantnerville Dr. (0.5 mi, at First Bank Sign). WestInn Kennel is 500 feet down on the left.

NOTE – the ramp from south/east bound Route 61 (from Troy) onto westbound I70 is closed!
