I would definitely bring some food item to gather them together but I was thinking possibly of bringing board games of some sort just so that we can sit down and chat and get to know them on a deeper level. Once you have that level of trust the Lord open their hearts to hear what you have to say about him. It's an amazing process.It's really good for people to get out there and see who the truly poor people are. You'll find a lot of people come out with us are actually more spiritually poor then the men are physically poor. You definitely get to see the scripture come alive... That in giving you receive.....
