Terms and Conditions

Application and entire agreement

- These terms and conditions apply to the provision of the services detailed in our quotation (services) by PACS Marine Engineering Ltd a company registered in England and Wales under number 9167747 whose registered offices is Marathon Works, Newport Bridge, Middlesbrough, Cleveland TS1 5TG (we or us) to the person buying the service (you)
- 2. You are deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions when you accepted our quotation or from the date of any performance of services (whichever happens earlier) and these Terms and Conditions and our quotation (the Contract) are the entire agreement between us.
- 3. You acknowledge that you may have no relied on any statement, promise or representation made or given by or on behalf. These Conditions apply to the Contract to the exclusion of any other terms that you try and impose or incorporate, or which are implied by trade, custom, practice or course of dealing.

Interpretation

- 4. A "Business day" means any day other than a Saturday, Sunday or bank holiday in England and Wales.
- 5. The Headings in these Terms and Conditions are for convenience only and do not affect their interpretation.
- 6. Words imparting the singular number shall include the plural and vice-versa.

Services

- 7. We warrant that we will use reasonable care and skill in our performance of the Services which will comply with the quotation, including any specification in all material aspects. We can make any changes to the services which are necessary to comply with any applicable law or safety requirement, and we will notify you if this is necessary.
- 8. We will use our reasonable endeavours to complete the performance of the Services within the time agreed or as set out I the quotation; however, time shall not be of the essence in the performance of our obligations.
- 9. All of these Terms and Conditions apply to the supply of any goods as well as Services unless we specify otherwise.

Your obligations

- 10. You must obtain any permissions, consents, licences or otherwise that we need and must give us with access to any and all of the relevant information, materials, properties and any other matters which we need to provide the Services.
- 11. If you do not comply with clause 10, we can terminate the Services.
- 12. We are not liable for any delay or failure to provide the Services if this clause by your failure to comply with the provisions of this section (**Your Obligation**).

Fees

13. The Fees (**Fees**) for the Services are set out in the quotation and are on a time and materials basis.

- 14. In addition to the Fees, we can recover from you a) reasonable expenses including, but not limited to, travelling expenses, hotel costs, subsistence and associated expenses b) the cost of the Service provided by third parties and required by us for the performance of the Services and c) the cost of any materials required for the provision of the Services.
- 15. You must pay us for any additional services provided by us that are not specified in the quotation in accordance with our then current, applicable hourly rate in effect at the time of performance or such other rate as may be agreed between us. The provisions of clause 14 also apply to these additional services.
- 16. The fees are exclusive of any applicable VAT and other taxes or levies which are imposed or charged by any competent authority.

Cancelation and amendment

- 17. We can withdraw, cancel or amend a quotation if it has not been accepted by you, or if the services have not started, within a period of 30 days from the date of the quotation, (unless the quotation has been withdrawn).
- 18. Either we or you can cancel an order for any reason prior to your acceptance (or rejection) of the quotation.
- 19. If you want to amend any details of the Services, you must tell us in writing as soon as possible. We will use reasonable endeavours to make any required changes and additional cost will be included in the Fees and Invoiced to you.
- 20. If, due to circumstances beyond our control, including those set out in the clause blew (Circumstances beyond party's control) endeavours to keep any such changes to a minimum.

Payment

- 21. We will invoice you for the payment of the Fees either:
 - a. When we have completed the Services; or
 - b. On the Invoice dates set out in the quotation.
- 22. You must pay the Fees due within 30 days of the date of Invoice or otherwise in accordance with any credit terms agreed between us.
- 23. Time for payment shall be of the essence of the Contract.
- 24. Without limiting any other right or remedy we have statutory interest, if you do not pay within the period set out above, we will charge you interest at the rate of 6.25% daily above the base lending rate of the Bank of England from time to time on the amount outstanding until the payment is received in full.
- 25. All payments due under these Terms and Conditions must be made in full without any deduction or withholding expect as required by law and neither of us can assert any credit, set-off or counterclaim against the other in order to justify withholding payment of any such amount in whole or in part.
- 26. If you do not pay within the period set out above, we can suspend any further provision of the Services and cancel and future services which have been ordered by; or otherwise
- 27. arranged with you.
- 28. Receipts for payment will be issued by us only at your request.
- 29. All payments must be made in BACS Transfer unless otherwise agreed in writing between us.

Sub-Contracting and assignment

- 30. We can at any time assign, transfer, charge, subcontract or deal in any other manner with all or any of our rights under these Terms and Conditions and can subcontract or delegate in any manner any or all our obligations to a third party.
- 31. You must not, without prior written consent, assign, transfer, charge, subcontract or deal in any other manner with any of you rights or obligation under these Terms and Conditions.

Termination

- 32. We can terminate the provision of the Services immediately if you:
 - a. Commit a material breach of your obigations under the Terms and Conditions;r
 - b. Fail to make pay any amount due under the Contract on the due date for the payment; or
 - Are or become or, in our reasonable opinion, are about ot become, the subject of a bankruptcy order or take advantage of any other statutory provision for the relief of insolvent debtor;;or
 - d. Enter into a voluntary arrangements under Part 1 of the Insolvency Act 1986, or any other scheme or arrangmenet is made with its creditors; or
 - e. Convene any meeting of your creditors, enter into voluntary or compulsory liquidation, have a reciever, manger, administrator or administractive reciever appointed in respect of your assests or undertakings or any part of them, any documents are filed with the court for the appointment f an administrator in respect of you, notice of intention to appoint an administrator is given by you or any of your directors or by a qualifying floating charge holder (as defined in para.14 of Schedule b1 of the Insolvency Act 1986), a resolution is passed or petition presented to any court for your winding up or for the granting of an administration order in respect of you, or any proceedings are commenced relating to your insolvency or possible insolvency.

Intellectual property

33. We reserve all copyright and any other intellectual property rights which may subsist in any goods supplied in connection with the provision of the Services. We reserve the right to take any appropriate action to restrain or prevent the infingement of such intellectual property rights.

Liability and Indemnity

- 34. Our liability under these Terms and Conditions, and in breach of statutory duty, and in tort or misrepresentation or otherwise shall be limited as set out in this clause.
- 35. The total amount of our liability is limited to the total amount of Fees payable by you under the Contract.
- 36. We are not liable (whether caused by our employees, agents or otherwise) in connection with our provision of Services or the performance of any of our obligations under these Terms and Condtions or the goutation for:
 - a. Any indirect, special or consequential loss, damage, costs, or expenses or;
 - b. Any loss of profits; loss of anticipated profits; loss of business; loss of sata; loss of reputation or goodwill; business interruption; or other third party claims; or
 - c. Any failure to performe any of our obligation if such a delay or failure is due to any cause beyond our reasonable control; or

- d. Any losses caused directly or indirectly by any failure or your breach in relation to you obligations; or
- e. Any losses arising directly or indirectly from the choice of Services and how they will meet your requirements or your use of the Services or any good supplied in connection with the Services.
- 37. You must identify us against all damages, costs, claims and expenses suffered by us arising from any loss or damage to any equipment 9including that belongings to third parties) caused by you or your agents or employees.
- 38. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions shall limit or exclude our liability for death or personal injury caused by our negligence, or any fraudlent misreprentation, or for any other matters for which it would be unlawful to exclude or limit liability,

Circumstance beyond a parties control

39. Neither of us is liable for any failure or delay in the performing our obligations where such failure or delay results from any cause that is beyond our control the reasonable control of that party. Such causes include, but are not limited to: power failure, Internet Service provider Failure, industrial action, civil unrest, fire,flood,storms,earthquakes,acts of terrorism,acts of war,governmental action or any other event that is beyond the control of the party in question. If the delay continues for a period of 90 days, either of us may terminate or cancel the Service to be carried out undder these Terms and Conditions.

Communications

- 40. All notices under these Terms and Conditions must be in writing and signed by, or on behalf of, the party giving notice(or a duly authorised officer of that party)
- 41. Notices shall be deemed to have been duly given:
 - a. When delivered, if delivered by courier ot other messenger(including registered mail) during the normal business hours of the recipient;
 - b. When sent, if transmitted by fax or email and successful transmission report or return reciept is generated;
 - c. On the fifth business day following mailing, if mailed by national ordinary mail; or
 - d. On the tenth business day following mailing, if mailed by airmail.
- 42. All notices under these Terms and Conditions must be adddressed to the most recent address, email address or fax number notified to the other party.

No Waiver

43. No delay, act or omission by a party in exercising any right or remedy will be deemed a waiver of that, or any other, right or remedy nor stop further excerise of any other right, or remdy.

Severance

44. If one or more of these Terms and Conditions is found to be unlawful, invalid or otherwise uneforceable, that/ those provisions will be deemed severed from the remainder of these Terms and Conditions (Which will remain valid and enforceable).

Law and jurisdiction

45.	This agreement shall be governed by and interpreted according to the law of England and wales and all disputes arising under the Agreement (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction fo the English and wales courts.
