<u>President's Report</u> – Ann Dynes said that Dan received a report from the City stating that local Advisory Groups will not be able to receive fees representing City moneys, nor handle their own banking as of the end of 2017. The City must administer the banking according to a City Attorney opinion recently issued. But she opined that, since LJP&B is a 501c3 as well as an advisory board, it is expected that LJPB will continue to operate as it has been, raising charitable dollars for its projects.

Ann reported that the missing metata /bedrock mortar from the sidewalk expansion at Cuvier Park/Whale View Point is safe in City storage. Future discussion is pending on its re-installation and location.

Ann reported that she had met with Meredith Dawson and Dan Daneri and walked Whale View Point and identified/ discussed California Coastal Trails signs. Grants from the California Coastal Conservancy may be available for City Parks & Rec in 2018, and the City is encouraging LJPB to identify an overall plan for the coastline. In addition, Ann would like to have a comprehensive LJPB position on the signage that is being installed along the coastline, including those designed to educate the public. Other sources of funding can be available for signage that is consistent on a state coastal level. Much discussion ensued among members.
