## Chapter 1

- 1 Paul, a *prisoner* of Christ Jesus, and *Timothy* our<sup>1</sup> brother, To *Philemon* our<sup>2</sup> beloved *friend* and fellow laborer,
- 2 to the beloved Apphia, Archippus our fellow soldier, and to the church in your house:
- 3 Grace to you and *peace* from God our *Father* and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 4 I *thank* my God, *making* mention of you *always* in my prayers,
- **<u>5</u>** *hearing* of your love and faith which you have toward the Lord Jesus and toward all the saints,
- that the sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgment of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.
- <u>z</u> For we have great joy and *consolation* in your love, *because* the *hearts* of the saints have been *refreshed* by you, brother.
- 8 Therefore, though I might be very bold in Christ to command you what is fitting,

15 For *perhaps* he *departed* for a while for this *purpose*, that you might receive him *forever*,

16 no longer as a slave but more than a slave—a beloved brother, especially to me but how much more to you, both in the flesh and in the Lord.

17 If then you **count** me as a **partner**, receive him as you **would** me.

18 But if he has **wronged** you or **owes anything**, **put** that on my **account**.
