Scholarship Updates (Tracy)

We award twenty \$100 scholarships to cheerleaders attending the Lobster Bowl towards their fundraising requirements. Applications to date have been 5.

4/8 counts of dance can now include a lift, side roll, roll allowing for more creative choreography.

Removing the minimum stunt & pyramid skills required. You will be based on what you do.

3 jumps now can be 2 of the same jump.

Rising Div 1- not restricted to thigh. Can do belly level.

Rising Div 1/Shooting 2- Allow vertical to horizontal

Shining 2- can do a braced (arm to hand) 2 leg extended stunt

Spotting changes- Rising Div 1 & 2 documented
