m W}$ elcome to the 2019 Hall of Fame Dinner! Redlands High School deeply appreciates your support and attendance.

RHS has a 128-year long tradition of excellence in athletics, and this night is a wonderful celebration of athletes, coaches and alumni that have been part of the Long Blue Line. We are just thrilled that this event is taking place on our own Terrier soil!

RHS enjoys a rich history of competitive athletics. If you scan the inaugural yearbook, you will find pictures of proud athletes, both male and female. One of the things that sets the Redlands High School Athletic program apart from other programs is the focus on character, ethics, hard work, and the concept of "team above self". We believe that this is one of the reasons that our teams and our athletes have achieved such great success through RHS and beyond, for a dozen decades. Throughout our history, we have fought for many titles, developed many great athletes, and been honored to support countless dedicated coaches. There have also been thousands and thousands of Terrier athletes that have participated simply for the joy of sport, for being part of a team and for being part of the RHS *Long Blue Line*. In addition, RHS is proud to be one of the founding members of the Citrus Belt League, and the only school that has stayed in the league throughout its history.

The 2018-2019 school year was another great one for RHS Athletics. The Terriers captured <u>seven</u> CBL titles including Girls' Tennis (15th consecutive year), Boys' Soccer (back-to-back champions), Badminton, Boys' Swimming (back-to-back champions), Boys' Tennis (for the 8th consecutive year), Boys' Volleyball and Softball. Last year, two Terrier athletes were selected as winners of the Ken Hubbs award, Kendall Bolock and Omar Yehya. Last year, **twenty-three** of our twenty- four teams received the CIF Scholar Athlete Award which is given to varsity *teams* with an average GPA of 3.0 or above. We would not have these opportunities for our students if not for our coaches. I am thankful for each of our coaches, and am honored to work with them every day.

At tonight's Hall of Fame celebration, we honor five athletes and teams who we are proud to call Redlands Terriers. Congratulations to Joe Hale, class of 2008; Narissa Marie Garcia, class of 2012; Erik Dahnke, class of 1984; the 1963-64 Boys Track Relay Team; and both the 2014 and 2015 Girls CIF Division II Championship Track Teams! My deepest appreciation goes to the members of the Hall of Fame Committee for making this event happen. It is an uplifting and enjoyable evening each year.
