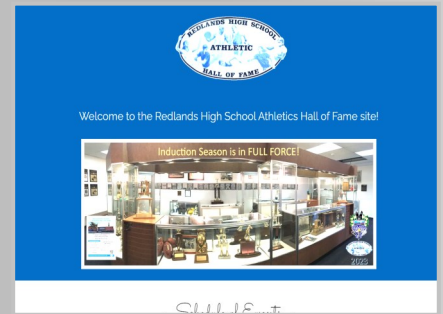

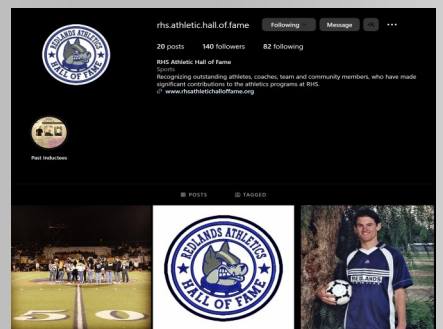

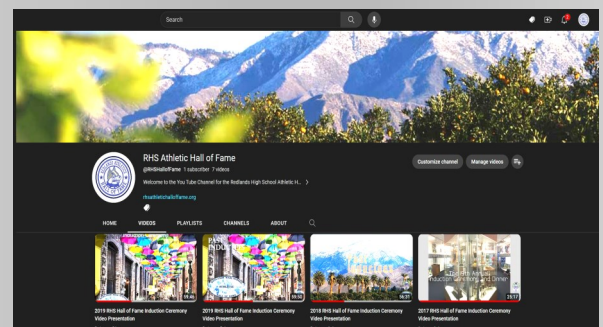

Redlands High School Athletic Hall of Fame—A Note From The Principal

Welcome to the 2023 Hall of Fame Dinner!

It is difficult to believe that it has been four years since we have come together to celebrate the contributions and achievements of Hall of Fame inductees. RHS has a 132-year tradition of excellence in athletics, and this night is a wonderful celebration of athletes, coaches and alumni that have been part of the Long Blue Line. We are just thrilled that once again this event is taking place on our own Terrier soil!

If you scan the inaugural RHS yearbook, you will find pictures of proud athletes, both male and female. One of the things that sets the Redlands High School Athletic program apart from other programs is the focus on character, ethics, hard work, and the concept of “team above self”. We believe that this is one of the reasons that our teams and our athletes have achieved such great success through RHS and beyond, for over a dozen decades. Throughout our history, we have fought for many titles, developed many great athletes, and been honored to support countless dedicated coaches. There have also been thousands and thousands of Terrier athletes that have participated simply for the joy of their sport, for being part of a team and for being part of the RHS **Long Blue Line**. *In addition, RHS is proud to be one of the founding members of the Citrus Belt League, and the only school that has remained in the league throughout its history.*

The 2022-2023 school year was another great one for RHS Athletics. The Terriers captured seven CBL titles including Girls’ Tennis, Boys’ Golf, Badminton, Boys’ Swimming, Boys’ Tennis, Girls’ Volleyball and Boys’ Volleyball. Eight teams went on to compete in CIF playoffs. Last year, two Terrier athletes were selected as winners of the Ken Hubbs award, Faith Deano and Cam Hopson. In addition, Caden Henderson was awarded the CIF Champion of Character award for 22-23. We would not have these opportunities for our students if not for our coaches. I am thankful for each of our coaches, and am honored to work with them every day.

Originally designed for the football program, it has grown to include all sports for male and female athletes, and is now considered *not-for-profit*.

The original costs were incurred by the first committee members through their individual donations. Today, as you would expect, not only have the costs skyrocketed, but the depth of the overall program has increased.
