



## Redlands High School Athletic Hall of Fame A Note From The Committee



*The Redlands High School Athletic Hall of Fame Committee is proud to announce the honoring of many former athletes at this 20th Annual Hall of Fame Dinner and Induction Ceremony.*

"Recognition of athletes, coaches, and others who have made significant contributions to the quality and success of athletic programs at Redlands High School....who have gone on to even greater collegiate and professional careers" is part of the mission statement of the RHS Athletic Hall of Fame. The tradition of the Hall of Fame is now part of many traditions Redlands High School has in it's 134 year history.

Nominations for the Hall of Fame are solicited from the community at large. Candidates are required to meet specific criteria, and selected members of the RHS Athletic HOF, community, and former inductees participate in the final selection process. Nominees not selected will continue to be considered for future induction (may require re-submittal of Nomination).

The Redlands High School Athletic Hall of Fame was inaugurated in 2002 by then Head Football Coach Jim Walker, who was inducted in the 2023 HOF Class for his community goodwill. Originally designed for the football program, it has grown to include all sports for male and female athletes, and is now considered *not-for-profit*.

The original costs were incurred by the first committee members through their individual donations. Today, as you know, not only have the costs skyrocketed, but the depth of the overall program has increased. Today, we rely solely on the proceeds of the dinner and rare small donations to pay for the dinner, advertising, printing costs, and inductee plaques and posters, as well as other incidental costs such as asset management (maintenance of our plaques, trophies, and other HOF assets). We have also increased our advertisement sales activity from the community to keep involvement in our events by you to as much as a minimum needed.

No committee member or officer is compensated. Work done on the new Hall of Fame Room has been completely volunteered by the committee members or provided by the school or district, and the effort for the annual induction ceremony is completely voluntary.

Your donations and your participation ensures the continuance of this worthy event that honors ALL athletes and alumni who have been exceptional at RHS and beyond, and to continue the tradition of the *Long Blue Line*.






**Dave Aranda** is not a typical Redlands High School athletic inductee that was known for his extraordinary HS stats. He rose from a high school linebacker sidelined by injury to become one of college football’s most respected defensive minds. He began his coaching journey at the high school level and steadily climbed the ranks then earned his philosophy degree at California Lutheran and a master’s at Texas Tech - from Hawaii to Utah State to Wisconsin - where his defenses ranked among the nation’s elite. His success led him to LSU, where he became the highest-paid defensive coordinator in the nation and helped engineer one of college football’s most dominant units, paving the way for national success. In 2021, as head coach of Baylor, he guided the program to its first 12-win season, a Big 12 championship and a New Year’s Six bowl victory (the Sugar Bowl), while redefining leadership by placing people ahead of players and building a culture of authenticity, growth and purpose. His legacy: a coach who taught his players - and staff - that the greatest victories are rooted in character, resilience and constant learning.

**Redlands High School (RHS)** is the oldest Californian public high school still functioning on its original site. Also known as **Redlands Union High School** or **Redlands Senior High School**, RHS was originally built in 1891 as a "unified high school", formed from elementary districts of Redlands, Crafton and Lugonia. Its Clock auditorium was completed in 1928. The Girls' Gymnasium was completed as a New Deal Era project by the Public Works Administration in 1936.

Located on 65 acres, the campus is divided by a major thoroughfare, State Street, into South Campus (the original site) and North Campus.






