#### **RULES OF ENTRY TO AWARDS**

- 1. All material performed in these Awards must be of COUNTRY ORIGIN.
- 2. All contestants must be a current financial member of a club that has been affiliated to New Zealand Country Music Association (NZCMA) at least three (3) months prior to these awards.
- 3. Current Overall winner of Awards eligible for the NZCMA Inc. Country Music Entertainer of the Year Award, are eligible to enter Awards but only in a different category to what they have already qualified. (Categories defined as Solo, Instrumental, Duo or Group)
- 4. **SECTION AGES** (As at 1st day of August at the commencement of the current NZCMA circuit year) .i.e. **August 1st 2023**

**TINY TOTS:** Up to 6 years - judged outright at auditions.

**JUNIOR NOVICE:** 7yrs and under ten (10) Must never have entered an affiliated Award.

JUNIOR: Under thirteen (13) years of age

INTERMEDIATE: Thirteen (13) years but under eighteen (18) years of age

SENIOR: Eighteen (18) years of age and over

VETERAN: Fifty-five (55) years of age and over

- 5. Where stage names are used full names must be advised on the entry form. Once accepted, no substitutes are permitted, but members of a group may be less than originally advised, but not less than THREE (3) members.
- 6. Contestants must be amateur as defined and not contracted to a recording company, or receive a major part of their income in the last FIVE (5) years from these activities. (Amateur is defined as not deriving a major portion of income from performing music).
- 7. Instrumentalists using electronic instruments e.g. keyboards, must not utilize memory banks for pre-programmed automated playing.
- 8. Competitors are restricted to their respective age groups with exception in the open sections.
- 9. Contestants eligible for the NZCMA Inc. Country Music Entertainer of the Year Award must abide by the Rules of Entry to the NZCMA Inc.
- 10. Any violation of the above rules may result in disqualification. In the event of a dispute or interpretation of the rules, the convenors decision will be binding on all parties.

- 1. The entry form must be signed and verified by the President or Secretary of the represented clubs after it has been filled in. **NO PHOTOCOPIED SIGNATURES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- 2. Backing band will be available for auditions in each section except Western Section. No other accompanist allowed unless contestant plays own instrument.
- 3. Contestants are required to provide **five (5) copies** of fully chorded song sheets, named with section and attached to a firm backing with non-reflective surface. Chord charts are to be handed in at registration. Finalists will be required to hand in chord charts by end of audition.
- 4. Contestants to perform one item completely in the Auditions. Finalists must perform a different item to that of the Auditions. All songs will be vetted and if unsuitable contestants will be contacted and given option to change song.
- 5. Contestants to report to official registration desk at least **thirty (30) minutes** before their advised audition time. Contestants not available when called may be disqualified.
- 6. Judging will be on Musical Ability, Presentation and Entertainment Value. Any count back will be on Entertainment Value.
- 7. **No harmony** allowed unless part of a duo or group
- 8. Finalists must attend rehearsals if required.
- The Awards Committee has the right to limit the number of entries, they may add to, combine, or delete from the programme where necessary and beneficial to the majority.
- 10. The Convener must be consulted prior to any recall being performed.
- 11. The organises reserve the right to record and broadcast any or all of the Auditions or Finals, subject to copyright conditions.
- 12. Contestants will give a signed undertaking to return any/all trophies in good condition when requested to do so.
- 13. Contestant's equipment is used and stored at their own risk. The Awards Committee will not be responsible for the loss, damage or theft of personal effects and/or property.
- 14. The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to any function. No alcohol or illegal drugs are permitted in the halls or backstage.
- 15. Contestants must not contact judges or scrutineers with the intent to influence decisions or allocation of points. **Judges decision** is final.
- 16. Audition times will be drawn by ballot. Times will be emailed if applicable otherwise self addressed envelope to be included.
- 17. Entrants in the Open sections are eligible to win Overall but are not eligible to go through to EOY.

# **SECTIONS CRITERIA**

#### **Gospel:**

Must have Christian influence. Contemporary Gospel accepted, no hymns. Duos and groups will be accepted.

#### Western:

Must be of the West, cowboys, cattle, the prairie, rodeo. This section is either self-accompanied on an acoustic guitar only, or with Awards guitarist on acoustic.

#### **Country Rock:**

Song may be any age but MUST have a definite rock feel not just a song sung at a faster tempo.

#### Waiata Maori:

2 songs as per normal entry, completely sung in Maori. Open to solo, duo or group no more than 3. Judging will include enunciation. No himene (hymns)

#### **Cross Over Country:**

This section allows for songs released under the pop label by country Music artists or songs released under pop that were recorded by Country Artists.

#### Instrumental:

No pre-recorded music eg. keybord. Band lead will stand down.
