Watering Instructions

Watering Your 15 / 30 Gallon Tree

Apply 10 gallons of water into the water retention area as follows:

- If the temperature is higher than 96°F: water **daily** (10 gallons each day).
- If temperatures are between 86°F – 95°F: water **every other day** (10 gallons each time).
- If temperatures are between 70°F – 85°F: water **two times a week** (10 gallons each time).
- If the temperature is below 69°F: water **once a week** (10 gallons).

Watering Your 45 / 65 Gallon Tree

Use 15 gallons of water in the water retention area as follows:

- If temperatures are higher than 96°F: water **daily** (every day).
- If temperatures are between 86°F – 95°F: water **every other day**.
- If temperatures are between 70°F – 85°F: water **two times a week**.
- If temperatures are below 69°F: water **once a week**.

Watering Your 100 Gallon Tree

Apply 20 gallons of water into the water retention area:

- If temperatures are higher than 96°F: water **daily**.
- If temperatures are between 86°F – 95°F: water **every other day**.
- If temperatures are between 70°F – 85°F: water **two times a week**.
- If temperatures are below 69°F: water **once a week**.

It is very important too:

Customers are responsible for properly maintaining their trees. This includes regular **fertilizing** and **spraying** to protect against **insects** and **diseases**.

First 2 Weeks of Your Newly Planted Tree

The first two weeks after planting are **crucial** for your tree's health. Make sure you are **not overwatering** or **underwatering** the tree.

- If the weather is cool, water once every other day.
- When the weather rises to 90°F or above, water twice a day—recommended in the morning and at dusk.
