Preview

The Good Samaritan shows us how godly leaders recognize and respond to brokenness. Learn how God sharpens discernment and compassion in the wilderness so leaders can bring care instead of chaos.

Scripture

Luke 10:33–35

Devotional

The Good Samaritan noticed what others ignored.

He assessed the situation, treated the wounds, stabilized the injured man, and ensured continued care. His response was not rushed or emotional. It was intentional.

In wilderness medicine and rescue leadership, recognizing early signs of injury often determines whether someone stabilizes or deteriorates.

God trains spiritual leaders the same way.

The wilderness sharpens your ability to notice pain, fear, and vulnerability in others. It teaches you to respond with steadiness instead of panic.

God forms leaders who know how to bring order to broken situations.
