Preview

God often speaks most clearly in quiet places. Discover how Elijah's wilderness encounter teaches leaders to slow down, remove distractions, and learn to recognize God's gentle voice.

Scripture

1 Kings 19:11-13

Devotional

Elijah expected God to appear through dramatic displays of power. Instead, God spoke through a gentle whisper.

The wilderness removes noise.

It strips away constant demands and distractions so leaders can learn to listen again.

In field leadership, good decisions begin with good information. Leaders pause before acting. They observe before responding.

God trains spiritual leaders in the same way.

Listening is not passive.

It is essential leadership discipline.
