Academic Updates to Courses

To allow for a more in-depth experience of our courses for students across both divisions, we have adjusted our academic program. Please take a look below on the new amendments.

- All ITT program courses are the same for the in campus and online division. This allows for continuity and alignment throughout our academic studies. The required textbooks for academic studies also the same (based off of phase).
- While our program courses will be identical in both divisions, we have different instructors teaching both divisions. Our academic instructors are credentialed through the approval of core leadership, our executive directors.
- Each course will now run for three hours, 7:00 PM- 10:00 PM respectively. The length of the course supports the recognized need for more time for student learning and academic support.
- All students (in-campus and online) will receive a 15 minute break from 8:30 PM-8:45 PM.

Phase Overview

- During **Phase One**, students can expect their biblical knowledge to be challenged. This phase explores the foundational aspects and panorama of the entire Bible. Each course offered is in relation to a specific book of the Bible. Students will learn about the historical context, the author, the purpose, the message, and the theme of each book of the Bible.
- During **Phase Two**, students explore the introduction to the study of various theological disciplines. Each course offered each course is in relation to concepts that are needed to fully understand the basic concepts of Christian Theology. Students will be developed and prepared for the last phase of certification and explore various elective courses.
- During **Phase Three**, students should be at a level of preparation where the knowledge attained in the previous phases can now be manipulated to learn more advanced disciplines of Christian Theology. Students are taught the core challenging major doctrines of the Christian faith as well as other Christian-based subject areas that require a preliminary foundation in the Word of God before studied.
