Powering up the device

1. Find the power switch in the rack and make sure it is flipped to the on position.



2. Wait till the 3 delay lights are lit up green



3. Find the power button on the back of the console. Press it in.



Recalling a show file

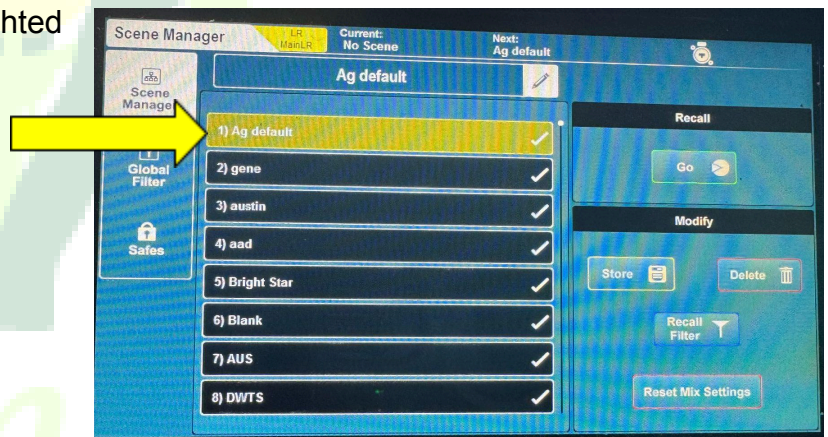
1. Once the board boots up, the screen should look like this.



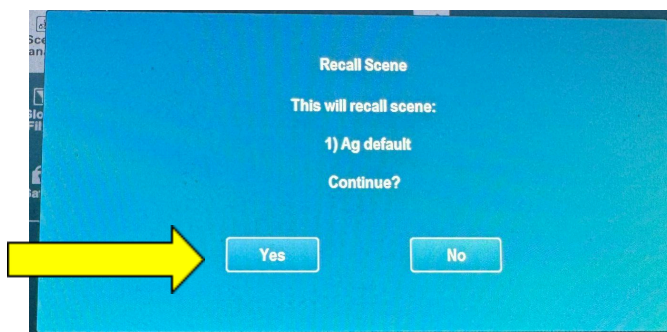
2. Click the button below the screen labeled "Scenes"



3. Make sure "Ag Default" is highlighted

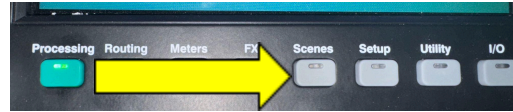


4. Click recall. Confirm Yes

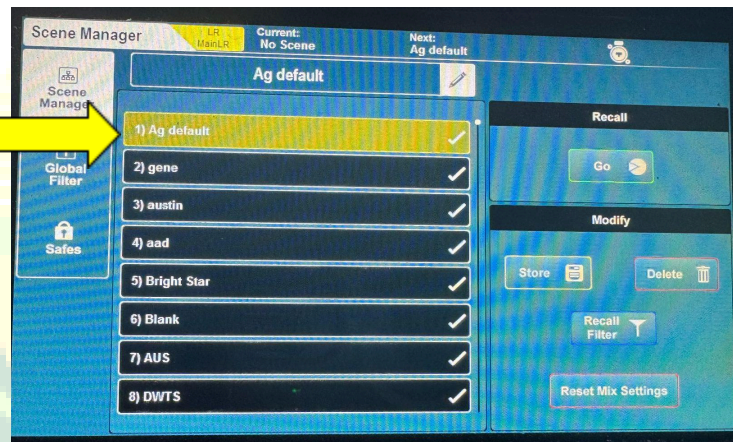


Saving a show file

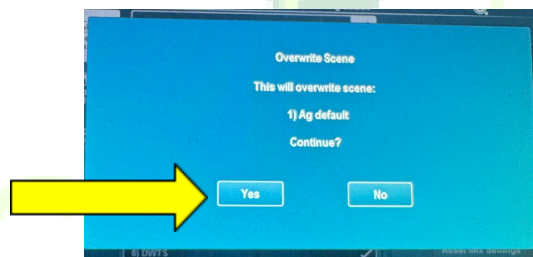
1. Click the button below the screen labeled “Scenes”



2. Select the show file you want to save. “Ag default”



3. Click save. Confirm Yes

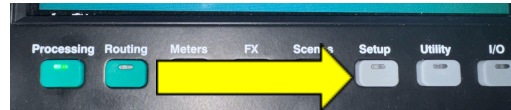


Note: **Always** save your show before powering the console down.

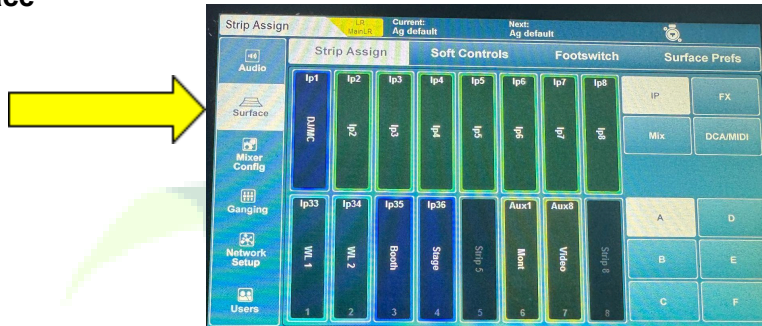

Editing layers

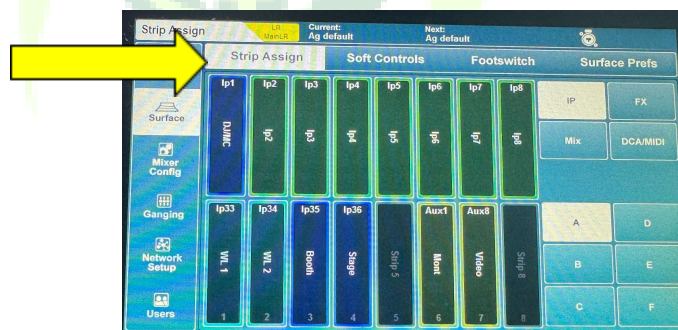
1. Click the button labeled **“Setup”** under the screen



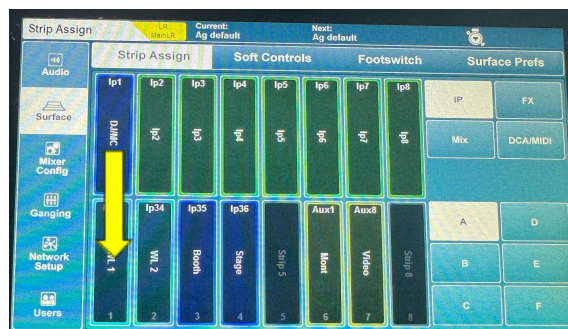
2. Click **Surface**

4. Drag an input from the top row down to wherever you want it.

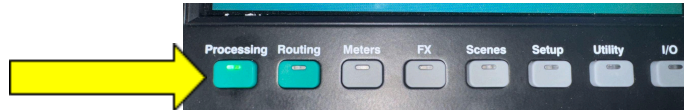


Powering Down The Console

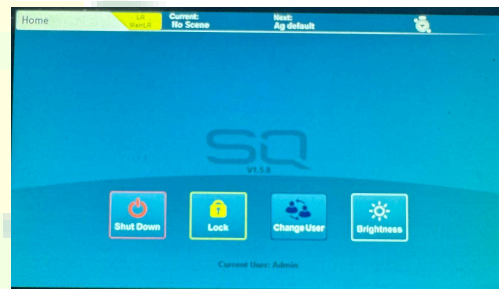
1. Make sure you have saved your show.

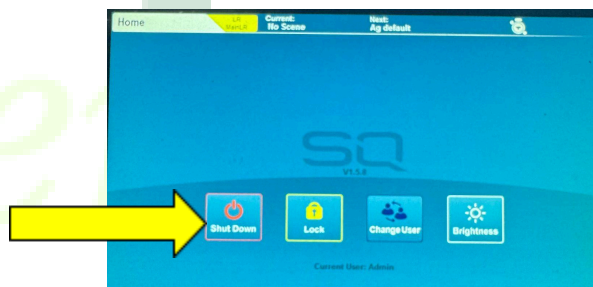
2. Click the **Processing** button at the bottom of the screen on the console.



3. You may have to press it a few times till the screen looks like this

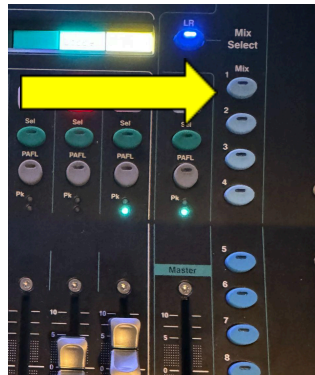


4. Press **Shut Down**



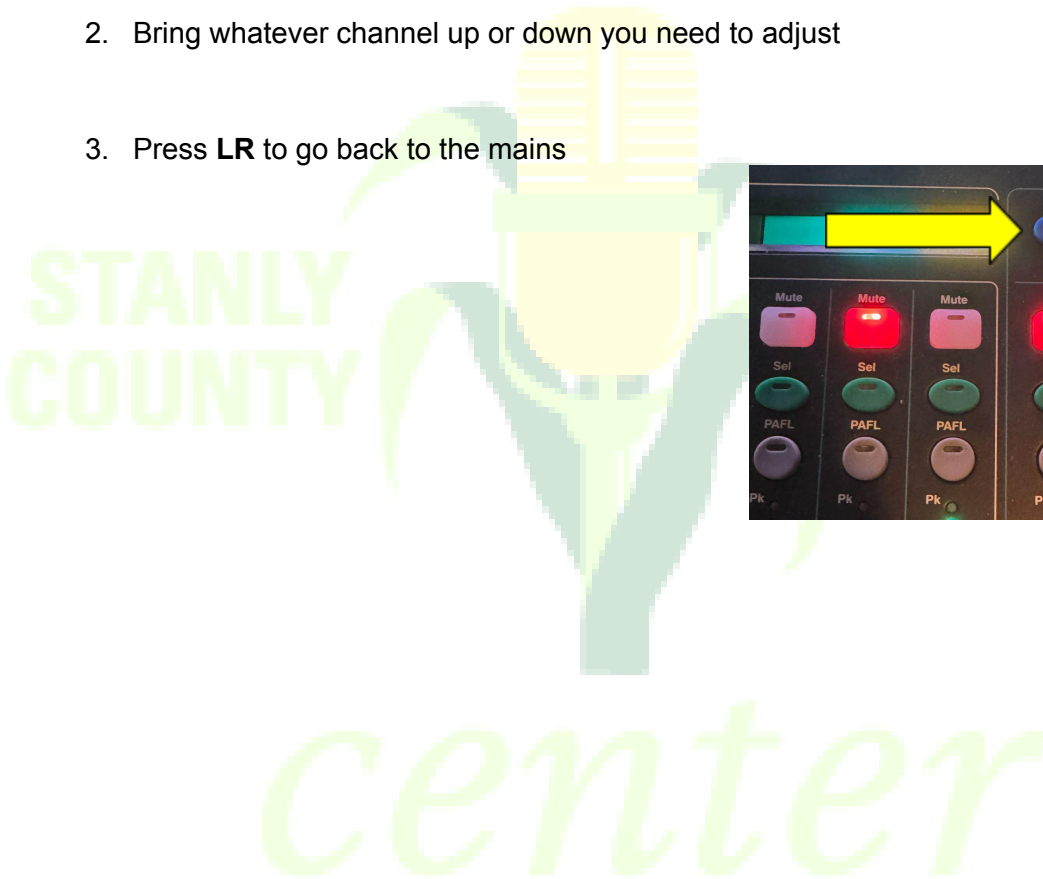
Editing the monitor volume

1. Press **mix 1**



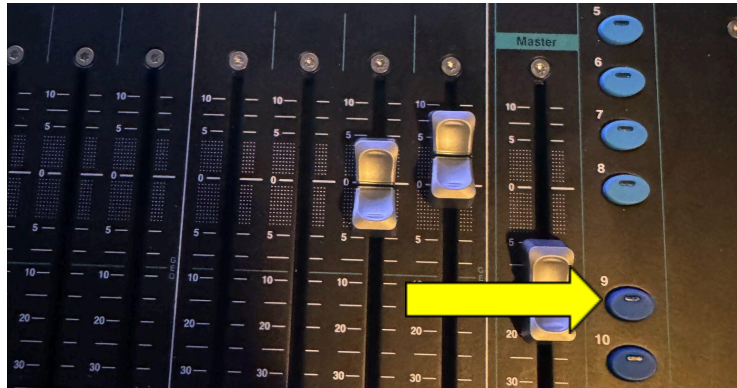
2. Bring whatever channel up or down you need to adjust
