Workplace Safety and Security -- Design Document

Business Purpose	As part of AIDA Healthcare's ongoing commitment to safety in the workplace for employees the purpose of this course is to fully explain what workplace violence is and to explain the warning signs of an escalating situation. In 2022, aggregate data showed 140 reported incidents of workplace violence across all sites. Our goal is to reduce these incidents by 80% or no more than 28 incidents reported across all sites. Through this module, it is expected that learners will be able to recognize the warning signs of physical and verbal violence and implement strategies to effectively handle both types of workplace violence.

Training Recommendation	It is recommended that this training be completed using an eLearning module to be completed by the employee and tracked by the Learning Management System. The reason for eLearning is the preferred method of delivery is the number of employees that need to be trained exceeds the logistical requirements necessary to train using methods of training such as in-person, vILT, and asynchronous training. eLearning is the most cost-effective option.
