There is something almost impossible to describe about looking into the face of someone who is family, someone whose life has been unfolding alongside yours all these years, even though your paths have never crossed. The Forge Evangelism Conference and Outreach, Nashville, Tennessee

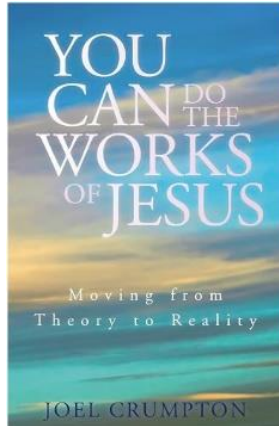
