Birthstone for October Opal

Louisiana Opal

Small amounts of a material called "Louisiana Opal" or "Louisiana Sand Opal" have been mined from the Catahoula Formation near Leesville, Vernon Parish, Louisiana. If you examine this material closely, you will find that it is a <u>sandstone</u> in which the <u>sand grains</u> are bound together by a cement of clear <u>precious opal</u>.

The material is not spectacular in appearance, but it is a genuine precious opal. It is a novelty gem that is enjoyed by local people and gemstone collectors. Small amounts of this material were produced in the late 1980s and early 1990s. It is no longer produced, and rough material is difficult to find.




